Introduction

I originally went the route of many activists, once tied up in the legal system I focused on "changing the laws," so the general population could finally get some justice. That was when I had a lot less

Chapter 1.

Do People Really Want Freedom?

There is only one other choice: Tyranny. Once educated on all options available and thinking long-term, most people would obviously choose freedom over tyranny. The greatest problem facing America today no thanks to corporate consumerism, is that very few people think long-term.

People are addicted to instant gratification while they literally waste their lives away. The future is of absolutely no concern. Most have nothing to fall back on in retirement other than “socialist” security.⁴ A growing number of Americans will blissfully hand over control of their entire lives for a monthly welfare check or just the mere half or third of their average yearly salary.

Twenty years ago, activists were fighting an entirely up-hill battle for long-perceived-gone rights. Most of us believed we didn't have a snowball's chance in hell of winning. Many of us

who were fortunate⁵ enough to be “awakened” by others were certain of our doom, but were reconciled to the fact that if we did nothing, that doom was certain.

Most Americans tend to fill up all of their free time watching TV and playing video games. Nobody even goes fishing anymore!

The tide is turning though, and you are turning it as you flip the pages of this book. Just 5 short years ago, perhaps 9 out of 10 people I would talk to about these issues would slam the door in my face sniping about how they are “not interested in politics.” Today, almost everyone I talk to is aware there is a serious problem, and being “not interested” in it can come back to haunt them if they don't know how things really work.

The facts are in the public eye for anyone to see, who is not immune to a bit of rubber-necking. You must have noticed your local peace officers morphing from friendly, white-gloved, proud men and women into black-suited, jack-booted, angry thugs who shy away from your camera, which is shining light on their obvious misdeeds? These thugs give perceived orders in the form of a request such as "Could you please step out of the car?" and if you do not honor their "request," you potentially face summary execution by the next Judge Dread wanna-be. Neighborhood peace officers now play judge, jury and executioner in every town and city in America. Clearly the terrorists have won. That's why it's time for a restoration of the principles which founded "the home of the brave."

The most frequent objection I get from people when it comes to standing up for their rights is that they have a family to think about and protect. I can definitely empathize with that feeling. That feeling is dependent however on the assumption that the problems facing more Americans every day are not eventually going to wind up on your doorstep. That feeling is also dependent on the

assumption that this is not going to be MUCH WORSE FOR OUR CHILDREN if you and I do nothing.

It may not seem like it when surveying our present problems in this country but dear reader, the fact is that you are “the government” in America. I'm the government. America is the only country on the planet where the average Joe or Jane on the street is the boss. The only other two links in that chain of command are people who promise by their oath to serve us and for the non-atheists out there, some One or Thing higher which granted us our Original Power.

If you are a novice on the study of American history you see “police officers” whipping⁶ insubordinate subjects of the STATE for “violations of law.” If you have a firm grasp on the concept of liberty you realize these poorly⁷ trained peace officers are unlawfully enforcing commercial regulations on people who are not using the roads for profit or gain. These traffic cops are attempting to limit our liberty by

controlling our right to travel, using the commerce clause as their excuse. They are on very disturbing power trips and need to be held accountable ASAP.

I've heard folks object to these views, talking of the chaos which would take place if anyone could do "whatever they want." When offered the idea of freedom for themselves, virtually everyone is all in. Most people are just concerned about how others will exercise their freedoms, if "allowed" the opportunity to do so.

Let's do some math. If the only one wanting freedom for you is you, and everyone else wants to infringe on that freedom, how much freedom do you have remaining? Seems pretty clear how we got from the "land of the free" to the land of almost complete voluntary servitude. Sorry for the curve ball here but could this problem be potentially blamed on that reflection in the mirror? If you didn't know is it your fault? What happens when you do know? Read on at your own risk...

There doesn't need to be some grand plan for mankind being put forth by evil unseen forces for the things you are seeing to occur. We've done it

to ourselves, by wanting to be in control of anyone but ourselves. These are the inevitable adverse effects caused by the free market's evisceration by selective regulatory enforcement. People with vested interests tend to do what is in those interests.

All this chaos in our current society is a result of public officials doing a whole bunch of stuff that was never part of their job descriptions. Treason is the norm for virtually all public servants in this day and age. If you're wondering why nobody has been prosecuted for it, why would someone who commits treason on a regular basis charge someone else with treason? You can't blame the servants however, they are "just doing their jobs." Who's job is it to give them their job descriptions? It's up to us.

Your rights are on the auction block and will be sold to the highest bidder if you do not show up to claim them. Tazers and prison cells are big business. They are built by massive for-profit corporations with high-powered bag men that lobby for more commercial regulation. If through media saturation you can be made to think these

regulations are laws, they take more of your perceived freedoms away.

To illustrate this point by what percentage do you suppose a tazer is used constitutionally? How many times on the evening news is the “constitutionality” of anything ever in question? Who advertises on “the news?” It makes perfect logical sense that corporations making tazers would want to relax the regulations on when public servants can use their handy tools of tyranny. General public acceptance of their new products plays a key role. If there is no uprising, it's business as usual and the “laws” can be changed at will.

The only check and balance on tyranny in this or any country for that matter is the people. Why does it surprise anyone at all when society becomes an oppressive dictatorship, oligarchy or kleptocracy⁸ once the people are sitting on the sidelines?⁹

Every year more “laws” are passed by politicians as kickbacks for campaign slush funds. These are not real laws but these politicians promote the fraud by saying the word “law” or “I’m going to pass a law” every chance they get, making you think they are in control of the very morality of society.

Governance Without Limit

If your town council votes to sacrifice your first-born child so that everyone in the town can be blessed with good crops this year, putting aside the lack of any evidence that murdering your child would be good for anything, are you now obligated to give him or her up for the “sacrifice?” Surely there must be some list of boundaries somewhere these public servants are not allowed to cross?

Virtually every public servant swears an oath to uphold and defend the constitution, against all enemies foreign and domestic, but has never even read it! Why should they if nobody is going to

enforce it? Why honor your oath of office when ignoring it will make you rich?

For some of us the answer is “because it's the right thing to do!” Let's face facts here in this text however: Most people tend to break even the rules they willingly agree to¹⁰. Electing an entire servant-sector that has any idea what “honor” means is not a realistic goal in our lifetimes.

If we're going to put freedom on hold until the servant-sector has nothing but Ron Pauls¹¹ in it we're going to be waiting around for a while. Freedom can be had for you, maybe not today but if you study hard and prepare yourself freedom truly is possible without the help of anyone, for a limited time only.

That's the power of knowing the law. “The pen is mightier than the sword.” As one of the people in this free country the law is your ultimate weapon enabling you to stand strong on your own two feet. The law is simple. My rights end where yours begin. We're all equal, so how can anyone be my

authority? How can you be my slave? There's no need for anyone to be leading the band because there is no band, we're all individuals with unalienable¹² rights.

If you haven't read the constitution there's no motivation for your servant to read it. S/he is not under any potential threat of being called out on a violation. Every color-of-law act committed by them equates to virtually all attorney "income" so do not expect any help from the legal sector unless you can pull the levers of it yourself. Only the threat of losing their job is going to get a public servant to listen, which means you need to know the law.

Now don't be scared. Learning the law is not an ominous beast. You just need to know where to start. This book is designed to give you a good foundation based on what's really going on, then I'm confident you'll be able to decide where to go from there. Your author has already done much of the "heavy lifting," sifting through all of the intentional distractions to get to the "meat" of the

law. Now you can take this knowledge and hence power to a whole new level.

Most working in the servant-sector don't care about your rights, and have never studied American history. Very few, if any use logic and reason in their daily activities. In this age of commercialized communism, almost every servant on the beat you come in contact with is "just following orders," and has no clue about the law.

Most public servants are completely oblivious of the fact they are part of an occupying force which is caging up their friends and neighbors all over the country. Virtually every arrest made in America today is not only fraud but also treason. Thousands of people are kidnapped daily based on presumed commercial obligations¹³ and held for ransom just so these supposed servants can justify their jobs.

Does your local police department look a lot like an army? Weren't our founders opposed to standing armies? They are now occupying every

street corner in America. What's next? If we do nothing now, how long will it be before we even have troops quartered in our homes? Oh, but that's crazy talk right?

We never really lost our freedom. We've just been presumed to have entered into private contracts¹⁴ with commercial entities where we've waived our rights guaranteed by the founding documents, in return for certain "benefits" and "privileges" this well-established system of commerce has to offer. The good news is, any presumption made by these corporate actors can be trumped by a simple objection. If you comply absent direct use of force, that cooperation is presumed to be your silent consent to whatever you are being "ordered" to do.

In all other countries people are subject to a dictator, monarch or oligarchy. These people were given no choice. People in other countries are considered property of the STATE, regardless of their will. Agents acting on the part of the STATE do with the people as they wish, with or without their consent.

When our Founding Fathers won the War for Independence, Americans as individuals won all the rights previously enjoyed by the King of England.¹⁵ Each one of us is heir to our throne. All we must do is occupy it and defend it with honor.

Your home is your castle. If you don't feel like royalty then it's time to explore what happened to all the rights we the people once freely enjoyed. It is my sincere hope you will have developed your own definition of the word freedom after reading this book, instead of "Freedom, With Their Exceptions."¹⁶

Due to recent revelations from Edward Snowden, a former NSA subcontractor, it is no longer a "conspiracy theory" that the "powers that be"¹⁷ are able to watch literally every move we make. There is a data center in Utah¹⁸ which is vacuuming up virtually every word and sentence you utter. Are you sure that nothing you've said in

your past could be taken out of context and used against you? Is anyone even capable of being that careful? Is that mathematically impossible?

What's stunning is the lack of outrage over these soft-ball corporate news outlets being "fair and balanced" about whether our right to privacy is important or not. Should there be two sides to that debate?

Our servants have been caught red-handed recording every word we say that they can get their grubby paws on. Amazingly¹⁹ this story seems to have already run its course and the general population is back to bliss as usual.

Regardless of what you may think about the law and the current state of our rights in this country, you've surrendered every freedom to this point voluntarily. If you trade your rights for benefits and privileges, you are bound by duties and obligations in return. It doesn't matter that you thought you were required to do these things. The point is, you're a big boy/girl now and you're supposed to be making intelligent decisions.

You're supposed to be doing your own research, not just doing things because someone told you to do it. What's the old adage about your friend telling you to jump off a bridge?

Someone told you that you needed to get driver license. Nobody told you that in "their" language, "DRIVER" is a commercial occupation subject to thousands of codes of commercial regulation, because nobody told them. Pull up the "Right to Travel" brief online for a stunning compilation of high-court decisions regarding your right to travel unencumbered for pleasure or necessity. The only regulations that are lawful by the constitution are when the public roads are being used for profit.

Someone running a delivery business and is partially responsible for wearing down the roads is reasonably expected to pitch in a portion of his/her profits to maintain that road. If you're required to have a license to get in your car and travel to the store for a loaf of bread, you are being taxed without representation. The constitution expressly states taxation without a representative stream of "income" is unlawful. If you're broke how can you be taxed? If you're poor do you still

have the right to eat, and hence not have your food money be taxed away?

Isn't a horse in many ways just as dangerous as a car if no more? A car is at the complete control of its operator. A horse has a mind of its own and can kill with one kick. A horse could kill a dozen people if it got spooked in the middle of a crowd. Why were we the people not required to get a license to ride a horse? Was there even an age requirement to ride a horse? Which amendment in the constitution granted power over "motor vehicles" to the servant-sector? Your author thinks it's the same one which gave the servants power over all horses!

Very few people look up these codes and try to decide how legislators went from enumerated delegated powers to do this or that, to being in supposed control of our rights. Few public servants will ever tell you what your rights are. Your rights are his/her limitations. People don't like limitations. How many rules do you want to follow? Public servants don't enforce their rules on themselves unless someone makes a stink about it.

America is a free country. People are free to subjugate themselves for little or no money regardless of any constitution written by men long dead. People are free to slink away while their rights are violated and allow the rights of their fellow countrymen to perceptibly blow away like the pages of never-read history. People are free to do all of this, as long as they remain free.

Americans have come to terms with the fact that most corporate actors only care about their bottom line, their own freedom and have absolutely no interest in helping anyone else. For some reason most that I've spoken with still do business with many of these corporations. They do have great prices, you know? How many can ignore the fact that some 8 year old in Bangladesh or somewhere is getting beaten black and blue because he asked for a ten percent raise, of one penny? I'm just guessing on this hypothetical, but it's an educated guess.

The solution to that problem which could get in the way of a great deal is to not want to hear about the problem. "I've got enough problems than to worry about some poor kid." Getting paid nothing

forces people to look for such great, but morally unsound deals.

In a land of abundance people would naturally have more time to get better educated and make more intelligent decisions.

There are solutions out there which can put the power back into the hands of the people. More importantly there is a huge market for these solutions today because there are so many of us. Your job is to put as many of these solutions into practice as possible and you will be greatly rewarded if not in the financial sense, that sense that you feel you did a good job when you're lying on your death-bed. Don't put off changing your life until dying. Too many people make that mistake.

If you're not part of the solution or you don't even know what the problem is then in some way or form your energy is fueling the problem. At the very least hand this book to someone else who will find it interesting if you're "too busy right now" to read all the way through and implement some of the suggestions.

You do not have the right to be ignorant. If you are ignorant of your rights, the effect is: You have no rights. If you have no knowledge of your rights how can you protect them? Attorneys will not protect your rights because their first loyalty is to the occupation, not the client paying his/her retainer. Most of your rights conflict with his/her bottom line. If you have a right, you shouldn't be in court in the first place! Attorneys would be out of business if people were educated about how to effectively assert their rights "at the scene of the crime." Instead, today we have a population of sheep who need an attorney to negotiate their ransom agreement.

Most people don't comprehend that when the rights of others are violated, a precedent is set which allows their own rights to be violated. If it is generally accepted that our servants can "stop and frisk" us whenever they want then when you or I say "no" that is treated as insubordination and we are likewise punished for "obstruction of justice" or "resisting arrest" depending on whether or not you made any physical move to defend your liberty.

If you are not infringing on the rights of others and your liberty is still under threat, how is that freedom? If you are not able to exercise your rights without interference, it can only be considered some level of tyranny, depending on what rights are important to you. There is no gray area with respect to your rights. To allow any gray to come into the picture gives our servants the ability to legislate from black to white.

Staying free takes work because there are always people out there who like to lazily sit on their rump and give orders. Sometimes restoring freedom takes “spilling the blood of patriots and tyrants” as Thomas Jefferson said. At the very least it takes a nation of people that isn't hooked up to a boob-tube for 4-6 hours per day.

The vigilance it takes to be free has been steadily broken down over generations by corporate TV programming designed to bring in profits. Exercising your rights without permits or licenses is not financially beneficial to anyone but you. If you think you need permission for something there are always “agencies” out there willing to sell it to you. There are permits and licenses for

just about everything now, all stuff our grandparents did without asking anyone permission, except perhaps their parents.

Let's consider the addiction to easy credit this permission system has created. Imagine being in the "permission" business. Your job is to get more "laws" passed which require people to get more permission right? Are there commissions and bonuses for being willfully ignorant of people's rights as well?

If you are asking someone permission for something aren't you placing them in the "authority" position over yourself? Aren't you saying "You're the boss?" Are they claiming to be an authority or is someone just calling them that? Are you sure they have the lawfully delegated power you are seeking or are are you just making an assumption? Do they have the jurisdiction²⁰ to grant you this permission or are they taking advantage of you in order to turn a profit?

There's an massive industry employing millions of people that is dependent upon you getting

permission for everything. Plea bargains, prison contracts, judicial retirement accounts and political lobbying for more “regulations” people think apply to them are all part of the corporate matrix which is dependent upon your ignorance in order to thrive.

The bulk of all arrests in this country are now made without any probable cause. All of these arrests are felony crimes if made on an involuntary basis. Usually there is no affidavit of probable cause in the “court” file because there is nobody willing to swear the arrest was lawful under penalty of perjury.

Why do we have the “right to remain silent” only after rouge public servants complete their unlawful interrogations? How did we go from being “secure in our persons” to being forced to bear witness against ourselves on demand at the side of the road by armed strangers? Why are we considered “insubordinate” when we stand up for our rights even though we are not subordinates to our servants?

For “Legal” Advice, Consult An Attorney

A big secret regarding the multi-trillion dollar legal industry is that “your” attorney's first loyalty is to the commercial “court” system, regardless of who is paying the bill. People that need an attorney to speak for them have declared themselves fair game. “This one isn't going to put up any kind of a fight, let's make some fast money!”

These are not courts. They are for-profit businesses. The goal of a business is to make money. “Government” businesses make money from regulation of “the governed” through fines, fees, red tape and do not make a dime if you're innocent. The attorney for the defendant is much like the slave master negotiating a reasonable price with the plantation manager, who plays the role of the prosecutor.

These are not courts. These are corporate board meetings where employees receive their marching orders. If you are not “in the know” then you're presumed to be one of the employees, subject to employee rules. Dean Clifford says it best:

Statutes, acts, regulations and ordinances are more accurately described as “Public Servant Codes.”

One big assumption people make is that they are accused of breaking a “law.” The “charges” on any document you receive will imply that you have violated a “statute.” You will never see in writing that you broke a law. Statutes only have the “force of law” on “the governed,” by their consent. When you register to vote in this commercial statutory system, regardless of if your candidate wins or not, you're voting away your ability to self-govern.

Even though you're not outright saying “someone please control me,” you demonstrate your willingness to be governed by debating whether or not you committed a violation. You are saying this rule applies to you, but you are innocent of the violation. Instead you should be demanding evidence that you have previously agreed to the entire list of rules.

Since slavery was abolished you must consent to be governed. Your “voter” registration, socialist security, “DRIVER” license, IRS forms and other

commercial contracts all show your tacit consent²¹ to be governed. Nobody has physically forced you to fill out these forms. You only did it because you thought you had to or you would be thrown in a cage and raped by “Bubba.” Americans now submit to all kinds of forms of terrorism every day.

You will hear politicians say the word “law” but you will never see it written down on paper as a law. In fact every single “law” you've seen passed on TV is not a real law. This is all just a clever deception by those who set up a slick corporation called “UNITED STATES” instead of “MCDONALDS.” Is the servant-sector making rules and implying you and I have to follow them when that is not the case? Even if you flip burgers for a living, if you don't work for MCDONALD's corporation do you have to follow its rules?

If these supposed dictates really are laws then why not just call them “laws” on paper? These are the questions you need to be asking yourself in order to start freeing your mind of the corporate

matrix. If you are free, you are not required to do business with anyone, regardless of the name of the company or what it sounds like.

WAL-MART is a government entity. It governs it's employees. UNITED STATES is also a "government entity" which regulates its human resources²². A "US citizen" is a title. It is your rank in commerce and it is the lowest rung on the corporate ladder similar to a "private" in the army.

When was the last time you got a paycheck for performing your US citizen duties? What is it called when you are employed by someone else but never get paid? Some people call that volunteer work, others call it slavery. The difference is whether or not you are doing it against your will.

Since slavery has been outlawed there has to be some way out of the matrix for those of us who do not wish to volunteer. The erosion of our freedom is an illusion. We still have access to all of these rights, it's just that public servants are used to

running the show instead of following directions. The directions they agreed to in advance of getting their jobs are in the Bill of Rights.

When you read the Bill of Rights you will see the words citizen, Citizen, people and persons. All of these words have different legal meanings. A US citizen and "one of the people" are not one and the same. The first part of the deception is making you think that a "US citizen" is anything other than what it actually is, a corporate title such as "Doctor" or "Esquire."

Some would say this is a legal trick while others point out that it's as simple as third grade grammar. You were taught in school that a personal noun or "name" is spelled with the first letter in each word capitalized. The rest of the name is lower case. How many people out there who passed the third grade are answering to something that IS NOT their name?

Capitalization of an entire word has no grammatical rules whatsoever. It is a complete fiction. These fictional words are presumably names of corporations. If the name you are answering to is capitalized you are presumed to

be there on behalf of a corporate, legal fiction and are obligated to its debts as a surety. You should know this stuff. Didn't you at least pass the third grade?

UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT corporation is set up much like a "democracy." You have stockholders, employees and a "president." The people in this country by and large do not realize they are being treated as employees and vote as stockholders. Just like in any corporation, employees are free to also be stockholders that enjoy the benefit of voting on how the company is run.

US citizen is your title when you are at work. When you are at home just being "one of the people" you are the stockholder with a vested interest that the corporation runs smoothly so your dividend gets a boost or the stock price goes up. When you sign any document for the servant-sector you are presumed to be signing as an authorized representative for your stockholder account. Even if they want to presume an employee status, are you on duty at your non-

paying job 24/7 and therefore subject to the rules all of that time?

If you didn't know this stuff, the banksters are literally robbing you blind. Since today in America "debt" is considered spendable credit, millions of dollars of charges can be debited to your account without your knowledge. The PTB then uses these credits to purchase guns, bombs and tazers. We are the source of the energy which powers tyranny and finances the tools of our own enslavement.

The reason "they" have gotten away with it for so long is that we've been trained in public school to "respect authority." You've been taught to "never take the law into your own hands." Remember having to raise your hand to go to the bathroom? Were you ever told you couldn't go do this thing which is as natural as breathing? Few realize, let alone are able to teach you that in this country you are the authority. I'm one of the authorities here because I'm one of the people.

The Importance Of Voting

In 2010 a landslide of about 80 Tea Party members took positions in Congress. After some exciting

soapbox speeches and great public debates, they were quickly absorbed into the establishment. 75 of these freshmen voted to extend the Patriot Act as evidence of this assertion. If one still points to voting as a solution after verifying this fact, we won't be right? How many of those remaining 5 stuck to their Oath when lower profile yet clearly unconstitutional legislation came across their desks? Are we now basking in liberty? How is that voting working out for us?

I'm making the assumption that most folks who read this book are already aware that the Patriot Act is the most overt assault on our freedom since this country was founded, granted it is all done under a cloak of supposed voluntary participation. For those of you who live in a cave or under a rock and are reading this text because it just blew by let me break it down for you: The Patriot Act seemingly puts the servants in charge of the castle!

I'm sure by now some readers are saying "I've never seen any of this on TV." You will not see anything on TV that doesn't somehow benefit the banksters because they by and large own TV. All

they want is for American couch potatoes to cheer on team USA.

Consider how much time the average American spends cheering on their favorite sports team. If that team wins there is zero benefit gained by the fan. What are the benefits gained if someone honorable is elected to political office? Why isn't it elementary that you should be cheering for a sheriff candidate running on upholding his oath to the constitution, who will defend your freedom, instead of your favorite sports hero?

You will find plenty of alternative information available online that's not all wrapped up in the flag. It's extremely important you become familiar with the great debate surrounding the Patriot Act if you haven't already. My hat is off to the thousands of independent journalists and researchers out there who have brought this very serious problem to our attention.

We are either currently living in a dictatorship, with more rules to follow than we could possibly ever become aware of in our entire lifetimes, or we have waived our rights in return for at least the perception of benefits. I hear we must all "pitch

in” from some people who generally like to be in control of others. Can someone please explain to me why I must pitch in to support anyone other than myself?

I'm not saying I'm someone who doesn't help people. My point is that definitions can blur the lines between help and harm. We've all heard the story about teaching a man to fish. A hand-out in anything other than a very temporary form can actually harm someone's long-term ability to provide for themselves.

Getting free stuff is not the same as freedom. Once someone becomes addicted to the free stuff they lose the motivation, desire and sometimes even the know-how to be independent. It is a very slippery slope between going to the food bank “just this once” out of desperation and having that trip replace your weekly ride to the grocery store. Close to 50 million Americans are now unemployed, many by choice so they can live out their meager existence on a “government” check.

People fail to make the connection between getting a hand-out and giving up their freedom. Take for example the peanut-sized weekly payments some

are willing to live off of. Bad habits are incredibly hard to break and there's a ravenous appetite in the corporate world for more irresponsible behavior. Free food and hence control of the food supply has been a most potent weapon of tyranny down through the ages. Even if we were to completely trust those in control of our food supply, isn't it completely irresponsible that we the people have allowed these controls to be put into place? Very real controls such as limited access to food, water and power only exist because we have lost our independence.

There is very little freedom left in America, according to this author's opinion because also in his opinion freedom means "I do not require anything from anyone else." How many of us can make that statement, perhaps one tenth of one percent?

If you can grow all your food and are not taxed on your land you for the most part have no needs outside of your sphere of control. This is the path back to freedom for all of us. We must all learn to fish again, so grab your pole and let's go fishing!

Chapter 2.

The Spectacular Scam

In order to access your power, you need to know how it's being conned away from you. First, you've been conditioned to believe that anyone in uniform is your "authority." You are then given requests that are in the tone of an order. There is the expectation that an order will issue, should you choose to disobey the "request." Should you choose to deny this request the presumption is that you will be assaulted, kidnapped and thrown in a cage with murders, thieves and rapists. Oh my! Well since you have "nothing to hide" and are a "law abiding citizen" you decide the easier and less painful route, is to just comply.

This is how your "voluntary" cooperation is won by your servant. Most people have no idea of how the chain of command works in America. If educated on your rights, you would be confused at any presumed order which violates them. A question should be asked regarding how this servant got his/her presumed power.

At the age of thirty-eight during a financially tough month, one truth about the world became crystal clear to me. It was at a time when I was beginning to build a solid foundation in my law research. At this point most of us realize the vast amount of information we were never privy to, and at least have a good idea of what we don't know. The reason life is so hard for many of us is because an "elite" class of society is parasitical on the second class, which has not been kept in the loop about how the world really works. If you don't know there are two classes of society, you are in the second class.

The people in the "elite" class are privy to the knowledge that is required in order to have true freedom in the commercial, human resource system. Those in the second class are not aware they are being treated as commercial property by agents of some corporation, because the name of the corporate STATE is similar to the state name they make their living in.

You'll see quotes used many times throughout the course of this book. I often quote words to disclaim the layman's definition so you realize

those particular words could get you into trouble, if you are unfamiliar with their legal meaning. Are you confused yet?

If someone asks you a question in Chinese and you do not speak the language you will say "I do not understand." If someone asks you "Do you understand the charge?" to something you think you comprehend but do not, you will say "Yes." Surely in this legal setting, you were not aware you were being asked to stand under the charge?

Once the veil has been pulled back, you see the problem more clearly. If you can see a problem clearly, the solutions become apparent. In this case once you know the language, the scam is revealed. Now you can give an accurate response which is based on your intent, instead of the reaper's presumptions.

Let's use an analogy to further illustrate how we got into this mess. Consider a honorable king with a vast kingdom, a huge army and hundreds of servants to do his bidding without question.

The servant who questions this king without a damn good reason will be fired instantly, as soon

as the king's patience wears thin. This king runs a tight ship and does not allow his servants any leeway when it comes to questioning his decisions, and following his directions.

Lazy Sacks of...

Now consider a lax king, lenient on his servants and allowing them to gain more power because he doesn't feel like doing his job. The king withdraws from his duties to govern his kingdom. The servants of this king are fortunate. They are mere serfs, yet have finagled a way to live like royalty.

A generation goes by, and the king's heir is now used to a different kind of kingdom. This is a kingdom where the servants do whatever they want, and barely recognize the prince's authority. In some cases, they even mock him when he tries to make his servants do their jobs correctly by barking back at him: "This is the way we've always done things."

I could continue this story, but I think you get what I'm ~~driving~~ traveling at: Most people in

positions of power do things not based on any constitution, since perhaps 1% have even read it. Instead they do things according to how they: "have always been done." It's my job and your job, to change how they do things.

It's difficult to blame someone who needs a job and agrees to work in the servant-sector, most of them perform their jobs to the letter "as they've always been done." The problem is, these people are being trained by corporations that have no interest in freedom, only corporate profits.

Employee manuals state how specific actions are supposed to be handled. "Justified" use of force is clearly defined. There is no secret conspiracy. The training materials are available to the public. We're not teaching peace officers how to do their jobs correctly. These manuals plainly detail how to set up a martial-law type force.

I hate to sound like a broken record, but we the people have been asleep at the wheel for a very long time. The job of inspecting these manuals before they go on to dictate how we will be treated is ours, if our servants are just that: Our servants.

Attorneys write the training manuals and virtually every "bill" which has ever graced the halls of congress or any state capitol. Almost every servant-sector document in some way, shape or form is approved by an attorney before publication. Every new rule passed is more power and influence for the BAR mafia. Very few regulations ever come off the books for the same reason: it's just bad for business.

Legislators are on the record stating they do not even read the bills. All three branches of the servant-sector defer to attorneys to see if this or that is "legal." A BAR led oligarchy is already in place and the general public is hopelessly enslaved to it, due to their lack of any education in law.

99.9% of people are like a deer in the headlights in any courtroom situation. When one does the research many questions are answered. People aren't screwing up. The system is designed for corporate profits. It's not going to get any better until you do what's necessary to defend the rights, life and liberty of your family. Most of us won't do what it takes, but it doesn't take many of us to

show the rest that there's a better way. If enough of us choose a better way for the right reasons, it becomes common sense for everyone else.

"STATE OF" x that you "live in," is a corporation which has a self-defined service area equal to the geographical area of the state you say you "live in."

Did you get all that? This is similar to how a utility company operates. You're not required to buy electricity, but it can be a useful benefit. One benefit of employment with the STATE is socialist security.

Socialist security is roughly the same idea as any corporate 401k plan, with the exception that the employees know the retirement contract is voluntary. For those who don't know they can opt out, they don't know they have a right to not even have a "number" at all.

In this socialized system of human resources doing business round-the-clock, very few have any idea they are being treated as volunteer

employees.²³ Senator Harry Reid stated once after being backed into a corner "Taxation is voluntary."

Talk to anyone on the street and they will tell you that you are required to pay taxes, be enrolled in socialist security and you are definitely not free to change your "citizenship." The "privileges" US citizens have available to them have been dwindling rapidly but somehow these same people still believe this is the "land of the free."²⁴

When "STATE OF" x is on some legal document it is always referencing a corporation doing business as the governing body of the state. That is against treaty law in the Constitution if you were required to do business with any corporation just because you pitch your tent on dirt they service. These corporations do not own the dirt you are standing on, but most people think they have some inherent right to control it.

If you think these corporations slick enough to name themselves after US states have a right to rule us with an iron fist then you pay your dues.

Your continued homage to "STATE OF" x is financing your local socialist state services and continued violence is being perpetrated on the public as a result. Don't hate your humble but attentive author for pointing it out.

Most ownership deeds I've perused have contained the words "fee simple" on the document. The legal meaning of fee simple is "absolute." If you own your property unconditionally, why do you need to pay anything to live there?

The reason you don't know this stuff is because everyone is raised up to believe that only attorneys are allowed to "practice law." Analogous to our slave trading days: only free men were allowed to read. The slaves had to be kept ignorant so that they would not be educated out of their efficiently ignorant slave mind-set. Isn't this exactly the situation we have with the general public today? Isn't today's "attorney" our slave era's "white man?"

The commercial "court" system is inaccessible to the layman. People get into the legal industry for the ludicrous amount of wealth to be made. Most

attorneys do not choose the profession to defend truth, justice and the "American way." Instead they siphon off resources that would be accessible if people knew how to articulate their rights on demand. These profits would not be possible if our servants honored their oaths of office and the people were well-versed on their rights.

The goal is to make more profits, not defend rights. In order to do that more rights, such as the right of unconditional use of your property, must be masked or veiled so they can be sold to you. If you think you have the right, there's no way for anyone to sell you something you believe you already have.

Socialism is not a requirement, even though so many people want to require you to participate in their socialist schemes. People are paid well to do those socialist jobs, and there is no experience required. Servants are commonly hired for their lack of independent thought and their willingness to follow orders without question. They claim to work in "law enforcement," yet have no idea what the law is when confronted in most cases. It's unfortunate these people have no idea what

socialism is. They are just cogs in the machine of tyranny. The quality of even their own lives will deteriorate over time, due to their entire community being sold into slavery.

In a democracy, it's a piece of cake to control at least 51% of the herd, when you control the TV. If you control another 45-49% of public opinion, the illusion of choice is complete. An amazing "majority" of people are happy every 2-4 years when they "win," even though nothing changes for the better, even for that "majority." In reality, this "majority" equates to perhaps 20% of the population, due to lack of "voter" participation.²⁵ How do representatives gain power over the 80% that couldn't care less who is running for political office, and hence don't vote?

People go out on regular intervals and take the one action they think will make a difference. They feel like they've contributed. Every few years the stop-gap-pressure valve is released and the public never explodes. Losers in these escapades are convinced they must now "come together" for the

“good of the country” and stop being angry about how badly they're getting screwed.

It's quite a brilliant set up for the PTB. I'm frequently in awe as I study how perfectly everything fits together. People actually think they are free and believe that working 40-70 hours per week is freedom. Unless you're doing something you love to do, a “full time job” sounds a lot like slavery to this author. Why must we “work hard” with barely enough time to sleep and no time to pay attention, in order to be considered acceptable, productive members of society? The answer is in the question.

It's taken many years to put these pieces together. If you've already “got it” starting from being a card-carrying Republican or Democrat, I would be stunned. If you're feeling like when your dog or cat just got hit by a car, it's completely normal. When most people begin to absorb this information, the common emotions are anger at having been duped all their lives, and a bit of embarrassment for the same reason. Denial and an urge to burn this book are probably also to be expected.

If what I'm writing here makes sense to you, follow up on it. Get the documentation. Check the history. Find the cases and precedents which prove what I'm saying, or prove me wrong²⁶. The education foundation you will build by proving or disproving my assertions is invaluable. Never believe anything that hasn't been verified by you or someone you really trust.

Most who know what I know pull punches because they don't want to be put in the crazy box. That's one of the reasons the scam works so well. If I sound crazy, you can easily discount and ignore the information I'm presenting. If I tell you that in legal terms a corporation is a "person," you won't even bother to look it up, because that's crazy right?

The bankster matrix is designed to be so complicated that it takes years of research and study to know what's really going on. The learning curve is so wide that it is almost impossible to not confuse everyone you're trying to educate. When you explain this colossal problem to people it's easy to sound crazy. You're

already starting off with a few strikes against you if you aren't a "trusted" talking head on TV. Nobody wants to be educated by someone that's been effectively labeled "crazy."

I suppose by many available psychiatric diagnoses I could be tipped into the "crazy" box. Some with impeccable credentials however claim the profession of psychiatry is designed to keep the smart ones who figure things out, seem anything but sane to the rest of us out there grazing in the material fields. If I'm crazy, you can ignore what I'm saying and get back to your regularly scheduled programming.

Some of this stuff will sound crazy once you first take it in but you will gradually find it explains many previous curiosities about your daily life. Ignorance is bliss. That's true as long as the blissful remain perceptively free. Everyone can surely agree at least that we are losing more of our freedom every day, either by our own consent, or by an increasing list of things we think we have to do.

More and more statutes are passed by the servant-sector every year, while very few if any are taken

off the books. Every one of these “acts,” can potentially affect someone's freedom in a negative way. All of them give at least the illusion of more and more power being amassed by the STATE.

This author's main concern is that we will reach a turning point, where the majority of people are convinced by the PTB that the minority who believe in Creator granted rights, should have those rights violated by direct force “for the good of the country.” The American people can be scammed into pretty much any war as long as you have enough money to spend selling it. Why should the next civil war be any different?

Article 1, Section 8 lists the powers that were delegated to the federal government. In all there are about 31 powers that our servants are lawfully authorized to execute. Does it seem like our servants have strayed outside that box? Can anyone come up with a tally on how many powers this global death machine is currently perceived to have? Can anyone count that high?

Where did they get all this power from? One thing is for sure, just doing simple math with only 27 supposed amendments and millions of statutes on

the books, all of which are perceived to be enforceable on the people, the PTB did not get these powers from any supposed constitutional amendment.²⁷

If a public servant uses his or her position in “law enforcement” to violate the rights of one of the people, is that not warring with the constitution? If you take an oath to the constitution and then proceed to violate it the next day, aren't you demonstrating that the constitution is unimportant to you? Aren't you a threat to the people? Shouldn't that be considered treason? When was the last time anyone was charged with it?

The monetary system in this society is a total fraud. It is designed to keep the population just-over-broke and virtually powerless. It is literally a game of financial musical chairs. You must rob Peter to pay Paul or you will not survive. I'm not going to get into the mathematical impossibilities in this book, but there is no way this ponzi-scheme can sustain itself as more and more of us wake up. Every “US citizen” who becomes “one of the people” is no longer supporting a system which is

way more dependent on us, than we have become on it.

The Federal Slave System²⁸ requires exponentially increasing debt in order to maintain "liquidity." People all over the world are getting more educated about getting out of debt, instead of building up more of it. A lot of these hints turn to clues when one decides to pay attention, and can perform basic math. If you diligently observe the problem, you can plainly see the math just doesn't add up. Eventually more and more people are going to perform this simple equation.

As of 1933, UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT corporation was broke. This is a very important year for the avid researcher, as many of the final gears of this fraud were put into place at that time. The people who, as usual were not paying attention, were made shareholders in return for a business loan so that "the government" could stay in operation. That loan is basically otherwise known as the National Debt. If you didn't catch what I'm writing here let me spell it out for you. The National Debt is not owed by the people to

anyone else, it is owed by the banksters, to the people!

It's enough to proverbially split your head wide open when you try to wrap your brain around it, but if we were to get back to zero on the National Debt number, the banksters would be mathematically broke.²⁹ The money changers need debt in order to survive. Due to the fact these people control every major "sector" of our civilization, the majority is so far under broke they will never see the light of break-even in their lifetime. In this crazy backwards society debt is used as money when in fact "debt" violates the definition of money.³⁰

If one group doesn't work, produces nothing and receives almost all the credit there needs to be an enormous pool of very poor, hard-working people³¹ to support them. As the demand on and size of that "serf" population grows larger, so does the likelihood increase that the serfs will realize they are slaves and that they have the PTB heavily

outnumbered. With these conditions in place, revolt is just a matter of time, and availability of information.

This has been the way of the world throughout history but that is probably because every time we come full-circle, a good chunk of our history is erased or forgotten. Historically, the Federal Slave System has only been around for a blink. I find it amazing that so many who are capable of basic math, have not been curious about what makes these green paper bills tick. These green paper bills run your life. Don't you want to know everything you can about them?

That's what "they" are afraid of. They are scared to death of people who figure out the scam because "they" are dependent on us. We the people are self-educating at an alarming rate thanks to the internet. This author is just plain giddy at the thought of CISPA, ACTA, SOPA and PIPA, because these are acts of desperation. We are seeing the death-throes of a death machine. Who could be anything but giddy about that?

There's no way to shut off even portions of the internet without the people pouring out into the

streets to demand it be turned back on. Whether you play mindless video games online, or you use the internet to educate yourself you will be equally miffed if they flip the switch. The sheeple and people will finally be forced into the same forum. Who do you think will be able to explain what's going on? Who do you think will finally be asking the right questions?

We the people will be calling the shots while everyone who never got the "we've been set up" memo, will be paying very close attention. It's the year 2014. There are now millions of us who believe we can be truly free. Every new soul who wakes to the "Golden Age" we are moving into, injects more energy into the lives of everyone else who has decided to be part of the solution.

Many freedom lovers agree that if everyone could be trusted, and they were willing participants, communism would not be such a bad system. Under current conditions a communist society that could sustain itself on anything but the smallest scale, is a pipe dream. How many people agree with the ideas of freedom, yet can't be trusted? One by one people are waking up to the idea that

respecting the rights of others, will make them rich by a definition which isn't found in any dictionary.

This author has an open mind. Everyone contributing to a general pot where anyone can take what they need to survive is a wonderful thought. In practice however most people take more than they need. This is why we need a free market system where greedy people can earn "more than their share," if they provide a quality product or service that truly benefits the public. Only customer satisfaction should guide the price, quality and style. A free market cannot exist in a system with arbitrary regulation.

The arguments for regulation always skip discussing who is going to be doing the enforcement. Enforcement is always handled on a selective basis. Human beings are the ones deciding who will be regulated. Yes the statute states that all who perform this or that activity will be regulated and must be licensed. In the end it's up to the mood of the supposed servant, that determines what happens to you if you're caught for a violation.

Do we really want to live in a world where “authorities” all around us make up laws as they go? Of course not. Nobody wants that, yet so many people acquiesce to it. So many people chop their nose off to spite their face when it comes to putting a servant in their place. To avoid a beat-down now they are ignoring the very strong possibility of a beheading or hanging later.³² Very few have the vision to see far enough down the road, to realize we the people are heading off a cliff.

The Declaration of Independence, Constitution and Bill of Rights are just pieces of paper. They can't do anything for us except to inform us of what the Founders of this country won, and intended for their posterity. They can live in the hearts and minds of people who believe in freedom, or they can die because they are burned and forgotten. They only have the life you give them.

“Authorities” will not follow the “law” unless we the people start enforcing it. Sheeple will not become people until they start realizing that they

are the authorities. There is a great wave of learning going on in America and around the world regarding self-evident rights and common law.

We are at a break point. The old system cannot survive if the people gain their freedom. There are many dependents on that system that are willing to flat out kill others in order to justify their careers. There are literally millions of people globally that cannot financially survive in a world free of debt.

“Insane” is a word I hear most often when someone is describing the mind-set of the PTB. When you have more “money” than you know what to do with, the only thing left is to gain more control over more resources because power is the ultimate goal. What are these sociopaths willing to do in order to keep their “income” streams coming in?

The evidence of their will is all around us. The “War on Drugs” is killing thousands of people annually even though it's completely unlawful (unconstitutional). FEDs are busting people in individual STATES that have “legalized”

marijuana, even though the federal servant-sector is supposed to be subject to the states. If you believe you have a right to exist, you are considered "armed and dangerous," because you are a threat to the lives of those who routinely violate their oaths of office.

Slaves do not have the right to exist. If "they" can take away your gun are they not hampering your ability to defend your life, and thus exist? The scam is not able to work on you if you're aware of the order of authority in America, and how this country was originally set up. There is no secret code. In less time that it took you to read these two chapters, the Declaration of Independence, Constitution and Bill of Rights would already be under your belt.

Chapter 3.

Is Civilization Civilized?

By definition, shouldn't it be? Well, let's look up the definition before we rush to answer this question. You're going to need to come to terms with the fact that if you're a little fuzzy on most of what we've covered thus far, chances are high that you've been misinformed about a great many things.

To answer this or any question intelligently, we need to know the definitions of the words, their context and the intent of the questioner. Too many people make uneducated assumptions based on layman's definitions when dealing in presumed commercial "law" situations such as being pulled over for a "traffic" violation.

The current layman's definition of the word "civilization" is a place with buildings, people and toilet paper. That's what the majority likely think about civilization. The primary condition that makes this reality possible, is that the people are not at war with each other. You can't have

buildings and toilet paper (for very long) if you're at war, and there are usually a lot less people.

Civilization is defined as a society of people who know the law and are therefore equal before it, because each one of us could theoretically defend ourselves equally and without violence. We would not be at the mercy of our bank account with respect to retaining a “good attorney.”

A civilian in Black's Law, 5th edition is a “person well versed in the law.”* Are you a civilian? Even if you're an attorney I can assure you, you're probably not well-versed in any real law. This is all a set-up. It's just one big perversion of law. The people's perception of “law” in America has been changed on purpose.

When one is pulled over by a “highway patrol” officer for whatever reason, there is a surprising amount of ignorance being displayed on both sides of the transaction. The assumed state of affairs is drastically different than what is actually happening on paper in the commercial realm.

By the Constitution, federal servants have been granted pretty much carte blanche to regulate

commercial affairs between the states. Your author muses that this was likely a common sense method of insuring all states would be playing by the same rules when doing business with each other, and no state would have an unfair advantage.

Due to this delegated commercial power, if you've signed a commercial document, you've never mentioned the fact that you are not doing business with anyone and hence do not require use of the road to complete some commercial transaction, you are presumed to be "operating in commerce."

The cop handing out tickets generally has no idea this is the case. He just believes he is enforcing the "law" handed down by the democratically elected "government."

Joe DRIVER is oblivious to his rights and has no idea that, to the extreme, he can lawfully refuse to hand over any documentation bearing witness against himself, including any "license" he presumably does or doesn't have. That license is your evidence of gaining the benefit of "driving" in return for the obligation of following the Motor Vehicle Code. The act of handing over that

document is presumed to be your agreement to be regulated as the "human resource" of a corporation.

You cannot be forced to bear witness against yourself. Translation: You cannot be lawfully forced to give up any information which can be used against you if you are the one on trial. Make no mistake, you are the defendant being sued by that cop who is holding "court," at the side of the road.

We the people by and large are not enforcing the rules anymore. Most of us think that someone in the servant-sector is charged with bringing to justice rogue public servants who violate their oaths on a regular basis. We the people made the rules, after which public servants then began to make rules for themselves. None of those public servant codes apply to we the people. The reason most people think they do is because the government here, you and I, hasn't been minding the store.

If those who make the rules do not enforce the rules, or at the very least explain the logic behind the rules on a regular basis, the rules will not be

followed. Isn't that basic human psychology? Do you think a public servant is going to point out to you whether or not they are violating their oath?

If you've never read our Founding Documents then how do you know what a public servant's job is? How do you know what was promised to you by your servants via taking their Oath if you haven't read the Bill of Rights? You've been guaranteed certain things by these people in return for allowing them to serve. Are you aware of these guarantees? They carry the same legal weight as any other private contract, duly agreed to by all parties, with full disclosure of the terms.

Be Good, for Goodness Sake!

Your parents likely were not aware that there was no requirement to send their offspring to "public" school, therefore you've been raised up to obey any uniform without question. Visits to the "Principal's Office" have conditioned you for this late-night shakedown at the side of the road.

You've been warned that "You better be polite, respectful and do everything he says!" Your life has been jam packed with fear of "authority" and now you're quite understandably paralyzed by that fear. Relax, take a deep breath and believe you are the one who truly has the power. Now all you need in order to build up your confidence level is more information which reinforces that belief.

If you study up on your rights and you know how to defend them peacefully, and without too much hassle, that fear starts to go away. You can now be thoughtful and responsive with the questions you will be asking your servant, instead of the other way around.

How many people identify themselves as a "civilian" yet have virtually no knowledge of the law? How many perform perfectly lawful acts yet believe they are breaking some "law" and hence acquire some feeling of wrongness, instead of feeling righteous?

Your author does not endorse any violent uprising, provoked or otherwise. The people have no clue about the black programs off-the-

reservation servants are privy to, as well as the weapons of mass destruction that are available, should rogue servants find the “justification” to be able to use them. There are a lot of independent researchers out there that believe time is on our side. The more time we have to sort out what’s been done to us on paper, the greater the chances that our discoveries could accumulate lawful precedents, as well as stark reminders to our servants not to, “cross that line again.”

The light is shining at the end of the tunnel. They can’t hold off a budding nation of future expert lawyers for much longer. The “land of the free” needs to become the home of the well-informed, if the people are going to be brave again.

Some lies were propagated lies by parents and grandparents who didn't know any better than you. History has been revised to make things a little more palatable, to those of us who may decide to define the word “freedom” one day for ourselves, instead of how TV sells it. To do that one must actually read the Bill of Rights and interpret it literally.

The Founders' goal when creating the Declaration of Independence, Constitution and Bill of Rights was for the layman to be able to comprehend them without an interpreter's help. Black's Law Dictionary, 4th Edition, was released right around the time our country was founded, so using it to look up words will enable you to clearly comprehend the Founders' intent.

Whose job is it to explain things to us? Can't anyone capable of reading a dictionary be able to comprehend the law? If the law is so complicated to where you need an attorney to explain it, how can you trust that you're being properly defended? How can you ever tell you're really breaking it, unless you have a BAR card?

When you ask a public servant a question about law, they always tell you to ask an attorney. They don't refer you to a book about law. They tell you to go get an attorney to explain things to you, in a language you can easily understand. That's the same as trusting an interpreter to speak a different language for you. You must have 100% trust in what "your" attorney is doing for you, because there's no way for you to decipher what she or he

is doing on your behalf, on-the-fly. Keep in mind, for most attorneys you are just another case. Your loss or win is dependent highly on your attorney's batting average. That batting average is entirely dependent on what you are willing to pay. How can we be equal, if our rights are based on a sliding financial scale?

That's the setup. People want money because they want rights. People see filthy rich other people, basking in freedom and believe hitting the lottery will grant them the freedom they already have, which is already guaranteed, by fewer than a dozen pages of documents they haven't bothered to read. Justice is perceptibly impossible to achieve for these people because most will never be rich. Since we're studying words, why would one want to be "filthy" anything anyway?

You're supposed to think it's impossible to get justice. That's how tyranny works. That's how tyranny maintains its stranglehold on power. You're supposed to feel helpless and powerless. It is virtually impossible to get justice if you just walk into a court and follow all of the "directions" of the "authorities" because the game is not set up

in your favor. The actual rules in play are not posted anywhere.

"The meek shall inherit the earth." In your author's opinion, that means those of us with honorable intent who know the law will eventually reap the rewards of abundance, free of outside coercion. That's all anyone really wants anyway, regardless of their present methods of trying to get there.

We are being taught one language in "public" school and then a completely different language is being utilized in these McDonald-Land "courts." Learning the law is also going to require learning the language. If we the people can stand on our own two feet and hold our own courts of law, freedom is attainable on a case-by-case basis.

The answer to the chapter title of course is "no." Mainstream society is about as far from civilized as you can get without a complete disintegration. There has been a total erosion of ethical standards in all big-business. One could say that civil order, where everyone is equal in the eyes of the law because they know the law, has broken down. By applying these simplified rules of honor, I clearly see how I was a huge part of the problem. The

game is rigged against “human resources,” in order to rake in obscene profits.

Present day society runs on debt and conflict, both of which are extremely profitable to the dinosaurs currently running the show. If you and I can't honor our word with each other, it doesn't matter if there is a “New World Order” group of collaborating conspirators; the writing is on the wall. Greed is what's driving this consolidation of global powers at a breakneck pace. It's the same game of financial musical chairs you play with your neighbors, just on a much larger scale.

What makes someone civilized is whether they can tell for themselves the difference between right and wrong. If you need an attorney to tell you whether you broke a law or not you are considered incompetent. You've handed over the keys to your castle, by signing a power of attorney if you do choose to retain one. This attorney can do anything in your name, as most of these agreements are unlimited and are never read by the client.

The law and medicine are two of the most critical industries that can effect someone's life, yet both

attorneys and doctors by and large have customers lining up around the block, who in most cases didn't even get a word of mouth referral. People trust these complete strangers with their lives simply because of the "Esquire" or "Doctor" title, even when considering some people tend to cheat their way through school or may be a little bit lazy.

In order to become civilized, you're going to need to get yourself a "code." I like my personal code of do not harm, steal or lie³³ all rolled up into a mantra of "Live with Honor."

Have you ever had dealings with people who live by their own personal code which seems right to them? Successful people have a code because they've developed the ability to think for themselves, outside the box which the general population thinks in.

Isn't it better to live by rules that you created for yourself, instead of those forced upon you which you do not understand? That's what freedom is all about!

Chapter 4.

What You Say They Are!

"I believe I have a right to write this book, without anyone's permission." The preceding is a redundant statement. A right is something you can do without asking anyone's permission. Your parents failed at their jobs, more than likely. Nearly everyone's parents failed this go around, in your author's humble opinion. How much freedom did you have growing up? How many rights would you say you had at the age of eight or so? Maybe our parents should have extended a few rights our way back then? At least now we would know what to do with them.

Today the average citizen feels that rights are things they must get permission from someone to exercise. They go through life searching endlessly for anyone who will grant them their wishes. From the time they wake up until bed, they dream of things they want to accomplish that are currently possible, if only that middleman granting all this mystical permission could be skipped.

If humanity began utilizing rights, en-mass, we could physically, legally and spiritually remake the world tomorrow. That good deed you would like to do for your neighbor? Why not just claim it, and "risk" the consequences? If you're truly not sure about a right but you're surely confident you're not somehow endangering anyone else, make a public notice of that intent. Reason things out. If everyone who could possibly be later involved with you after "going rogue" is put in the loop before hand, they can't claim ignorance of the fact that you clearly believed you had the right and therefore could not be in the wrong, absent any objections.

Your rights are what you say they are³⁴. The only exception is if 12 of your peers³⁵ unanimously disagree with you. Thousands of hours of research in law have brought me to this simple conclusion. Can you debate this as anything but fact? You can do whatever you want, as long as you're not infringing on the rights of others. If I wish to defend a right, all I need is one of 12 jurors to agree with me and my right is secure. Even if

you're not a gambler, isn't ninety-two percent a pretty good chance of winning?

Virtually everyone who ever lost in court has done so by plea-bargain, many with an attorney standing beside them. Is a plea-bargain given "voluntarily," if it was coerced through intimidation? That intimidation could be coming from "your" very own attorney, who only cares about his or her next payday. Rarely are the rights of the individual violated by the verdict of an informed jury of peers. Your neighbors would obviously not rule against their own freedom.

I do not underline words in this book that often. An informed jury of peers is paramount to your ability to defend your rights. Should you choose to step onto the court, be sure you are well informed about the process of jury selection, so that you can ensure your liberty will be properly defended. If a prospective juror has never read the Bill of Rights, you certainly do not want them on your jury and they should be disqualified.

Make sure the jury that will decide your case is informed about their rights specifically as jurors, in this wonderful system of "for the people"

governance. Be sure your jury knows they have the right to judge not only the facts of the case, but also the legitimacy of the supposed law someone claims you violated. As one of the people, it is your right to disqualify prospective jurors if you come to the conclusion they are not your peers. Ninety-nine percent³⁶ of prospective jurors can be disqualified using the following question: "Can you quote me, word for word, any part of the Bill of Rights?"

It takes one a bit of soul searching before making the decision to refuse a plea. Prosecutors terrorize defendants, threatening as much as ten times the fines and/or prison time if they wish to take their case to a jury. Magistrates commit the treasonous crime of jury tampering on a daily basis by telling jurors they "do not have the authority to judge the law." Jurors are instead told they can only decide if alleged facts are true, when in reality it is the magistrate who is the Trier of Fact and the jury is the final judge of what the law should be.

"Unalienable" rights are defined by Black's Law, 5th edition as rights you cannot give away. If

you're free however, you must be free to give up your rights, with the express reservation of the right to get them back. Americans by and large waive billions of rights every day. Those billions of waived rights add up to trillions in financial windfalls for corporations, many of them part of the Military Industrial Complex that President Eisenhower warned us about in his farewell address. If you have not watched it, this author adamantly urges you to check it out. His future prediction is dead-on.

You're facing a web of contractual obligations that make you part of the corporate matrix. The biggest threat corporations pose to individuals is to their rights. Every action a consumer makes is a potential profit center for some marketing firm. Imagine if consumers could be forced to do things instead of needing to be "sold" on them by mind-numbing TV ads: What kind of profits would be in store for the corporate CEO who could dictate what and when consumers will buy? It is already being done by corporate actors all over the world posing as "government" agents. Am I overstating things to say that this is a threat to liberty, of pandemic proportions?

You're a Free Agent!

The profits of the legal industry are in direct conflict with your rights. If our servants respected their oaths of office there would be an across the board 90% reduction in "crime." Most supposed crimes in this country are not crimes at all. They are commercial violations, unenforceable on anyone who is not affiliated with the corporation that created them. This fact is just another trump card with respect to your rights, because you cannot be lawfully forced to do business with anyone.

One important overlooked right even by many constitution buffs is your unlimited right to contract. I hear so many people complain about things being unconstitutional, but they don't realize they have privately contracted to waive their rights. The truth is with the exception of infringing on the rights of others, you have unlimited rights.

Only individuals are tangible and can be directly violated or protected with respect to their rights.

Corporations, groups, states and countries are all just figments of peoples' imagination. Corporations do not have rights. Groups do not have rights. States do not have rights. Countries do not have rights. Individuals have rights. Only rights which are self-evident to the individual are relevant. How many people have a clue about all the regulations which exist in the fictional world of commerce? How many people could comprehend over six million "laws?"

Common law generally means "What is commonly understood by all." This is absolutely not to be confused with "case precedence," denoting an entirely different ballgame. In common law no precedent matters, the only determining factor is the decision of a jury of peers.

As a bit of a primer in your constitutional education, read over the 9th amendment which basically says "just because we enumerated certain rights you couldn't encroach on we AT THE TIME felt were most important, do not think you can infringe on any others we didn't think to mention." The guarantee laid out in the ninth

amendment is your trump card when there's any confusion about what your rights really are. If there is any confusion: You've got the right.

Smoke Em If You Got Em

America's form of government is unique on this planet. At the conclusion of our War for Independence, a government "of the people" was formed. For the first time in history, a society was born where all people were equal in the eyes of the law. Rulers by divine privilege or force were effectively abolished in the eyes of the people. Each American could feel as safe and legally protected as any king or queen, and pursue happiness with virtually the same abandon.

We have now gone from being free, with the exception of infringing on the rights of others, to almost complete involuntary servitude. Our servants have assumed so much non-delegated power in the peoples' constitutional negligence that most folks think they are subject to their own servants.

No Holds Barred

If your town council votes to have every first-born child in the community sacrificed for whatever reason, perhaps good crops, should your neighborhood peace officer enforce that rule? No of course not! Your author sincerely hopes his readers wouldn't hesitate on this answer. Hopefully we're all in agreement. What about if they vote to take a limb, or a finger? Is that lawful? Again the answer should be unanimous.

Now people will tell me about how it is "illegal" to murder or harm someone unless you are under threat of harm or you are defending someone else. Are you sure? What if your local servant-sector votes differently? Are they able to do whatever they want? There must be some out-of-bounds stuff that they are not even allowed to bring up for a vote. There must be some boundary to their perceived powers. That boundary is the Constitution.

A politician without boundaries is dangerous. What's exponentially worse is someone charged

with keeping the peace who is not intelligent enough to realize the insanity of something like an "Official Town Sacrifice." If your peace officers don't know the law, how do they know when politicians break the law with their vote? Have you ever seen a member of "law enforcement" arrest a politician for attempting to vote on things that aren't his or her prerogative to vote on?

Most people have a hard time grasping this information, even when laid out in common sense principles. That's completely understandable, and one of the things you should do right now if you haven't already, is forgive yourself for being duped all these years by people who make bank on your ignorance. It's just business, don't take it "personal."

Is it lawful to carry out your job as the man who has been appointed to carry out the official town sacrifice? I envision the reader's mind splitting wide open as I write this. Clearly we are ruled by laws and not by people who vote on whatever the laws are going to be, however a super-majority of Americans now believe their rights are dependent on how some back-door-deal-making politician

votes. Is it any wonder why we have “lost all of our rights?”

If you don't know how to enforce your rights once you've decided to exercise them, you're going to be educated via the “School Of Hard Knocks.” Instead of re-inventing the wheel, let me refer you to a spectacular set of reference tools: Jurisdictionary. These tools can easily be found for free online however I do suggest a healthy donation. There are audio files and a PDF manual for explaining how the court process works and how to work it. There's also another PDF manual specifically devoted to the forms you're likely to use for most cases. Take back your power now by the honing the most powerful weapon in your liberty arsenal: Your ability to wield the law!

What's most encouraging about the above series is the attention paid to the appeal process. You are encouraged to keep the black robed man in line. He's is a referee and nothing more. He enforces the rules of the court. You make the moves, you call the plays and you make the decisions. Bill Thornton @ 1215.org has made some serious inroads into deciphering how you can be king of

your castle and plug into the existing court system, without ceding any of your power. Using the information available from both of these sources will build you a sturdy foundation in your study of real law. They will also build your confidence, knowing you can stand on your own two feet and defend your rights, when it becomes necessary to prove you have them.

Chapter 5:

Education Versus Programming

Once any good man or woman has knowledge of a problem, they naturally feel obligated to do something about it. The reason our servant problems have persisted for so long is that both Mom and Dad have been working overtime, in order to make ends meet. The average American has no time to flip back through billions of pages of legislation to figure out how things got so messed up.

Frequently while writing this text, your author has struggled with words. Should I use the layman's assumption so that I can communicate with you more easily? I would rather speak "legally correct," so that you naturally begin to "speak correctly" and find yourself getting into far less trouble. The latter case is most beneficial, as long as you can decipher the language.

Before we had the internet at our disposal, there was strangling bottleneck when it came to the average Joe or Jane's ability to learn anything

useful. In hindsight, I'm finding my current scope of knowledge in law is something I should have procured in elementary school. The ability to separate what is lawful from criminal, regardless of "rank" in society reduces my stress level more than anything else in everyday life. I can no longer be fleeced by the man or woman who is just trained to steal from me under color of law. It also levels the playing field when or if a bunch of servants want to gang up on me.

Knowledge of the law grants you the use of your own military force. Our servant-sector is tasked to support the common law if one of the people chose to implement its protections. If I am ever dragged into a court, I'm not some clueless newbie sitting on this side of the chessboard. I'm someone with a better-than-average chance to win. That makes me dangerous. That also makes me someone whose questions a public servant is not going to want to answer on a witness stand.

Do You Keep Up With "The News?"

Back in the 80's, FOX NEWS was sued by some of its journalists for censorship of their investigative reports on MONSANTO, regarding the dangers of

artificial growth hormone that is injected into dairy cows. It was a blistering condemnation of the entire corporate dairy industry. These journalists of course hired "Attorneys At Law" to defend their right to freedom of press. Can the BAR protect free press and continue to rake in these insane profits? Isn't an attorney's income highly dependent on people thinking they MUST hire one, in order to get justice? At this point in the book, my readers can likely predict the outcome.

FOX executives dictated the "facts" to protect one of their biggest advertisers. Clearly censorship of facts for financial contributions is not news. Real news requires an objective view. There were obvious violations of these journalists' rights to report the truth, if they had not already waived those rights when they contracted with FOX. The veil was pulled for everyone to see who was at least paying attention. The truth about the "news" became a legal precedent which protects all propaganda spewing out over the public airwaves today.

There is nothing "illegal" about FOX lying, inasmuch as they even have the right to dictate the

“news” however they see fit. FOX does not have to tell the truth in order to keep the word news in their name. Large corporations with deep pockets can assert their right to free speech without fear of retaliation. They're addicted to shocking viewers with useless information in order to keep them coming back. A corporation has no feelings. It's just a business with no ethical standards. It definitely doesn't care about what you would find educational or useful, it is dependent on what you will buy.

These “news” outlets are in the pockets of the corporate agents they should be confronting. Their main advertisers should be getting asked the tough questions. When the predators and parasites of society are advertising with big bucks on the “news,” can you get the information you need to make intelligent decisions? There's no mystery to why the “news” isn't really news at all. It's just a simple math equation.

You've Got to Free Your Mind!

The primary difference between education and programming is: are you really doing the choosing when it comes to what's going into your

subconscious mind? Your subconscious mind is like the hard drive on your computer. Once disconnected from the internet, the only information your computer can provide for you is what's on the hard drive. If your brain is constantly spammed with nonsense, you're going to have a hard time making sense of anything.

TV gives you the choice of multiple channels to flip through, but they are all approved or at least tolerated at some level by the PTB. Every show on TV has the blessing of someone in Big Oil, the Bankster industry, Big Pharma or someone else in BigCorpGov.Global who doesn't care about you. Let me repeat that. They don't care about you!

Every bit of information brought to you by TV has been approved at some point by someone working for a billionaire. How many billionaires do you know? It is more aptly called: "The Federal Department of Educational Disintegration." Bill Thornton does a great job of laying out how the high school graduates of today are less informed than a 5th grader was, 70 years ago.

On the internet you decide. You are the master-switch between every bit of information available online and your subconscious mind. The power at your fingertips is literally unimaginable. This is the reason a lot of people spend ten or more hours daily on the internet when they are first introduced to it. That's normal since their subconscious minds have been starved for information due to PTB control. The digital floodgates have opened, and people everywhere are in a hurry to get up-to-speed.

I also find James Corbett @ CorbettReport.Com to be a no-shock matter of fact journalist who can casually describe the forces of darkness in great detail. His knowledge of what's really going on all over the world is quite impressive.

On TV nothing but infomercials and entertainment to sell more commercials squeezes by. The "news" is highly tailored to the needs of the X Industrial Complex, weeding out anything that might hurt their profits. Anything useful to the people gets scrubbed out, and I don't know how to say it any clearer: They don't care about you. They DO NOT CARE ABOUT YOU. Why do people spend so much time caring about them?

All Sold Out!

After the last WWII crisis in Syria, during the fall of 2013, the CEO of UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT corporation, Barack Obama made some comments about "American exceptional-ism" that were as far from accurate as they were genuine. They were snide remarks. You could almost feel the resentment building in anyone who could not call themselves an American.

Let's pause for a moment here to make note of the fact that it is the system of selecting leaders that is the problem. To focus on any one puppet is to be mesmerized by the show. Politicians will no longer be able to thrive in this country, once the

people understand where their rights come from. They do not come from any document, nor were they granted to us by any group of men.

I believe the intent of Barrack Obama's words was to compel people who do not live in this country to reject America, and believe there's nothing exceptional about our country. If there's nothing out of the ordinary about America, it's much easier for the banksters to roll the whole world up under one easily manageable global corporation with millions of subsidiaries that controls all the people.

Let's hammer this point home further: If a politician votes to infringe on your 2nd amendment guarantee, but still loses, has he broken the law? This author says he has. This is power that was never delegated to politicians. They do not have the power to make any decisions limiting gun ownership, period. Any politician duly elected to defend the constitution is committing treason just by speaking out against it, absent lawful consideration of a constitutional amendment.

Yes they are just making rules for their corporation, but everyone is aware they presume to be able to enforce their rules on everyone. In

practice they try to do exactly that. The presumption is you are an employee, as a US citizen, who is subject to their employee codes. Would you consider this common knowledge? If not then the people making these presumptions are committing fraud.

In layman's terms, a presumption basically means that the facts are generally understood by all, are accepted and are not required to be entered into the record. You knew about all of these presumptions right? Very few people I've spoken with had ever heard about how the matrix really works.

The illusion of law is powered by fear and intimidation. Instead of "How can I help you?" servants, we now have order-following gunmen pillaging our people for fines, fees and taxes without representation. These re-venue³⁷ generating activities are acts of fraud. We've surrendered to the terrorists with flashing blue lights, occupying every town and city in America.

They strike fear into the hearts of every supposedly free American they pull over.

The illusion is also powered by many of these well-meaning folks who have decided they are going to learn all the statutes and beat the largest and most well-funded criminal organization on the planet, at its own game. These people run around saying the word "law" all the time when they're talking about are commercial regulations that aren't even applicable unless you're performing a commercial act.

At the age of 38 I read the Bill of Rights for the first time without being coerced to do so. I was stunned at our actual rights, versus the "privileges" we are now perceived to have in America. The difference between rights and privileges is that the latter can be taken away by a vote of the majority. Democracy is "rule by majority" so if you say you live in a democracy, can you also state that you have rights? If you live in a democracy, aren't you ruled by the mob?

So what is the Constitution? It's just a "God damned piece of paper," as George W. Bush reportedly said behind closed doors while being

questioned about the constitutionality of something. It's true the Constitution is merely a piece of paper,³⁸ at best it is a valuable artifact. It has no more power than any other piece of paper to do anything. I realize I am stating the obvious, yet people all over this country are proclaiming that the "Constitution isn't working," as if to say it could grow legs, get up and start digging a ditch or operating a bulldozer.

Let's say you're going on vacation and you're leaving your children home without a sitter. You leave a list of rules on the refrigerator. How long, given your children have no oversight, do you think they will follow those rules? To expect a public servant to follow the rules without enforcement or oversight from the people is exactly the same situation as if you were to expect your children to follow the rules in your absence.

The truly ridiculous, when one takes some time to think things through, is now the norm in this country. The people have been off-duty in this country for far too long. It's been generations since the layman on the street had any kind of working

knowledge of law. We've been distracted, bewildered and bombarded by millions of these arbitrary rules that are printed somewhere, but never brought forward unless it's to gain some specific advantage. When we bring forward the rules servants break, for some reason they no longer apply.

Eventually all rules are bent, and some are broken. In our analogy, the parents can either enforce rules they want the children to obey, or they must face the reality that the rules will probably not be followed. Why is it so shocking that the Constitution is violated on such a regular basis?

When was the last time you gave a short quiz to a public servant regarding his or her oath of office? Have you ever been witness to a servant violating someone's rights, yet did nothing about it? Your rights are under threat the moment another individual's rights are violated. This former shining beacon of freedom has gone dark. Are you going to take responsibility for the problem, regardless of how it was created, and become part of the solution?

We have to draw a line somewhere. While many people wish to draw that line in the sand, this author feels that's been done way too many times. A line in the sand can easily be wiped away. Will you take a stand and "carve a line in the concrete" instead? What I mean is will you pull out the Bill of Rights, look up the definitions and interpret the document for your own common sense?

I've never been to college other than a brief technical school, and have no degree. All of my study in law has been freelance, mostly via the internet. I've followed the guidance of dozens of different "gurus," in the realm of advanced research and new discoveries. My educational compass has been pointed generally in the direction of truth, as near as I can tell.

Is That a Law Book in Your Hand, Slave?

The legal profession does not like it when the casual scholar talks about law. A BARfly may speak the word "law," but you will never see one claim you broke a law under penalty of perjury. Any attorney can write the word "law" down on

paper, but only the most ignorant would put their "John Hancock" on it, swearing it's true.

Politicians talk about "law." Cops talk about "law," but you will never see any of these "laws" written down on paper as "law." They are always called statutes, acts, codes or ordinances. If you're required to obey these inter-agency rules, why not just call them "laws?"

The real law is self-evident. Nobody wants to be stolen from or harmed physically. Doing something "against the law" means that you are doing something that is in some way harmful to someone else. Here's a simple way to think about real law: If there's no injured party, there is no crime.

How many court cases in this country are absent an injured party? How many defendants are dragged into court by "THE STATE?" In most cases "STATE of X" is the plaintiff. Who or what is the STATE? Can the STATE sign a power of attorney agreement? If the STATE is the accuser then who do you cross-examine, the "governor" aka CEO? Who has put their liberty on the line if there is no probable cause at the time of your

"arrest?" If there are no witnesses or facts presented that would suggest you've committed a crime, haven't you just been kidnapped?

All these agents in servant positions are bonded, and operate under limited liability. They are insured against public harm, same as you would insure your auto against possible damage. The insurance company is gambling on if you're prepared to go the legal distance or not. It's not a risky gamble, as people almost never file a claim for violations of rights. Instead they "ask an attorney" and get the answer you can expect from someone whose meal ticket is on the line: There's virtually nothing they can do. These attorneys do not want you to know about the bond, for the same reason no other servant does, you may wish to re-seat yourself at the head of the table.

When was the last time you filed a claim against a public servant's bond? Isn't insurance against violating someone's rights basically "criminal activity" insurance? If you've taken an oath to uphold rights and you are insured against violating them, isn't that "treason insurance?"

I hope I've made it abundantly clear what the problem is and who has the power to implement the solutions. The solutions are self-evident. I'm no genius, I'm just an average Joe who has studied a wealth of information. I'm not telling you to be a martyr. I am telling you to learn the law so you can peacefully resist, gather evidence and get a judgment in your favor if necessary. This is the only true resistance that will eventually turn over the "just-us" system's apple cart. The first step for you, is to turn off the "news" and start pulling back the pages of actual history, for a self-education.

Chapter 6:

Powers You Directly Delegate

You do not have the right to not know your rights. You're responsible for making sure your servants know your rights, if you want them respected. If you shirk this responsibility, you lose your rights³⁹. You do however have the freedom to delegate your powers to your servants.

When I ask you the question "Who do you want to give your power to?" your answer most likely will be "I don't want to give my power to anybody," and that's common sense. If presented to you in this form, the answer is clear.

If someone asked you a question in Chinese and you do not know the Chinese language, you are most likely going to say "I'm sorry but I don't understand." When a magistrate asks you "Do you understand the charges?" you assume he's saying "Do you know what you've been charged with?" when in fact he's saying "Will you stand under the charges?" He's asking you to become a surety for

whatever new debts are tacked onto a commercial account which is "managed" on your behalf.

Once you've said "yes" to the question of "do you understand" the rest of the case is irrelevant. You've agreed to be bound by some contractual arrangement you're not even privy to. Next comes your plea, where you consent to be a regulated human resource, regardless of your plea. If you search through history you will find that at one point we could claim we were innocent. Now we can only hope to "not get caught" for our presumed crime.

What's happening is a clever deception to make you say "yes sir" or "no ma'am" to every request that is made of you by someone claiming to be a public servant. Most times the servant's question is answered based on the presumption that the answer is required. Usually answers are given based on the assumption physical harm will ensue if the answer is considered "insubordinate." A quick thumb through current events will tell you this is not an uneducated assumption.

This is how we "consent" to tyranny. There are powers we simply surrender over to because we

think the law says we have to. We believe the law is what it is because someone says so, usually it's someone with a badge. The epidemic started when the masses started entering into the Driver License, Birth Certificate and other socialist contracts. By default, every man, woman and child is considered to be doing some type of business 24/7 which must be regulated.

Article 1 Section 8 of the Constitution lists 31 powers our founders delegated to the servant-sector. These were items of convenience only. They were never meant to grant any power over life, liberty or our pursuits of happiness. That was always left to the people.

If you haven't reviewed the text you'll find the servant-sector is doing lots of stuff that hasn't been delegated to it. They create powers out of thin air simply by making a request so firmly that you think it is an order. If you refer to *Marlbury vs Madison*⁴⁰ you will find these powers do not legally exist if they are repugnant to the constitution. These are powers you possess which

you delegate on a case by case basis only because you think you are required to by "law."

In order to become less susceptible to ignorance, you must first accept that you have been ignorant. Your ignorance is extremely profitable to others, downright sinfully profitable. There are extreme forces in this world working to keep you ignorant for profiteering reasons. There are even agencies now designed to re-educate you, in case you're one of the ones who has begun to wake up.

If you wake up and realize who's really in charge, that's a serious problem for those who are dependent on easy money from folks who think they have to pay.

How could you put your hand on your heart and believe you live in a free country if you truly believe you are required to do all these things? Are you free to be born? If so then what if you don't have a "Birth Certificate?" Are you free to go where you please? If so then doesn't that make a "DRIVER" license redundant? Where in the constitution does it specifically delegate the power to regulate how people travel?

If we are free then only self-evident laws make sense to us. Nobody wants to be murdered, stolen from, raped and so on. These are not moral quandaries to anyone but complete outcasts of society.

It's pretty difficult to find a jury of my peers. Try finding 12 people who can tell you what their favorite parts of the Bill of Rights are, ninety-nine percent or more will give you a blank stare. Someone who knows their rights can really muck up the legal system and more importantly, they can do it at virtually no cost to themselves.

Consider that your first directly delegated power is giving out the place where you sleep, every night, to every stranger from Timbuktu to Broadway. If you've already broken yourself of this habit, bravo! Many activists today surprisingly want to take the "nothing to hide" route with their privacy instead of acquiring the best possible defense of their message (can't TOUCH this) that they possibly can.

Your right to free speech is eliminated by your willingness to keep a forwarding address. If any gang of thugs can come to your door and threaten

violence which alters your message in any way, we all lose. You must stay ON POINT as much as possible. Everything “they” are doing with tired old fear and intimidation tactics is designed to do one thing which gives them the keys to the castle: Distract you until you are focusing more on “them” than on what’s morally sound and true to your own spiritual character.

The next right you give up is the right to travel when you ride your bike down to the DMV and get yourself a “Driver License.” At the green age of 16 or 17 you’re in reality hired as a volunteer public servant, bound by all codes. “UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT” is no different in its legal structure than WAL-MART. Both entities are “federal corporations” and to see for yourself look up Title 28 3002 Section 15 for the definition of “UNITED STATES” according to “federal law.”

Have you driven a tax-cab or a delivery van? These are some of the only professions which actually require a commercial DRIVER LICENSE. Do not be fooled by the “personal” DL, Black’s Law, 5th addition allows for corporations to be considered “persons” when the word is used

“statutorily.” The only venue a corporation can act in is commerce.

There are a few very well put together documents online showing clearly the difference between for-profit “driving” and non-profit traveling for recreational use of the roads or for necessity such as going to the store for a loaf of bread.

Forget about what the “law” says for a moment: If you travel to the store for a loaf of bread have you made any profit? Since the answer is no then essentially you are not using the roads in commerce. Are all these fines, fees and all other revenue generating codes examples of taxation without representation?

Oh but then we get the “bleeding heart liberals” who believe that nobody⁴¹ would use their “freedom” wisely and that's why we can't have it. To those people I swear... Aren't we supposed to be opposed to communism over here? I know we were pretty opposed to it in the 60's, 70's and 80's. Isn't Lee-Harvey Oswald the commie spy and “lone gunman” who killed JFK?

If you stretch the time-line out to infinity, doesn't everyone around you who does not believe you would use your freedom responsibly and therefore wishes to control it, a threat to your very life? I know this stuff sounds extreme but when I woke up and smelled the roses one day I realized there were no gray areas. Areas only go gray when the freedom goes away. If someone wants to regulate your health supplements isn't that a threat to your life?

Once the "right to bear arms" was infringed by "unless one is an ex-convict" it became second nature to start taking away guns from anyone else for whatever "good" reason. I trust my gun way more than I trust the word of any politician who wants to take my gun away on the premise of protecting me. If that kind of thinking is considered "adult," then why do we bother even moving out of our parent's houses in the first place?

Do you see how gradual and slippery that slope can be? Even I could almost justify taking the self-defense right away from someone who has committed murder or more heinous crimes, but I

have a much wider view of the big picture than most.

The constitution grants power to take away the right to bear arms "once duly convicted" however it does not grant an extended power to take away the right once someone has done his time. Where did the servant-sector get this extra power? The only way for them to get more power is a proposed and passed constitutional amendment. It's quite the trick to lawfully pass an amendment. A constitutional amendment must clear 2/3rds of both the house and the senate. It must also get through $\frac{3}{4}$ of the state legislatures. All this must be accomplished completely without edit, by a bunch of egomaniacs. One could say in today's political scene: It's impossible.

You decide if someone is going to tell you what to do or not. Only the most completely ignorant public servant will ever order you to do something. It is always a question or a request. Sometimes there is a firm inference that violence could be committed against you in the form of an assault and kidnapping. We are controlled by the fear of losing our liberty or our life.

That is ironic because those are exactly the fears that should be driving us to stand up to all this tyranny. Most people are trained to think about the consequences in this moment, not what happens down the road. It sure seems like this is all according to some plan. When you understand the problem the root causes become clear. America's greatest problem is the "get it now" addiction, damn the consequences. Find the root causes of that problem and you're going to be getting a lot closer to figuring out the solutions.

Don't get me wrong here. There are some people out there who run an ethical business. The core problem and difference between commerce and common law is that corporations are not legally set up to "care" about people. The only interest of a corporation is the bottom line. They are actually set up ethically and legally protected in order to screw the public.

Obviously you would not go and donate your hard-earned cash to a corporation that is in the business of killing people. These corporations have to find some way to trick the creditors of America into financing their endless wars on

terror, drugs and other predictably impossible to win endeavors. The longer each one of these wars lasts, the more bombs, missiles and generally instruments of harm can be sold. Many people are just trying to defend their lives from the very corporations who are selling all the weapons.

There is no war on terror, but there is a war on the people. Is this a calculated plan by some group of control freaks or just the predictable effects of this money-grubbing plague? It's obviously helpful to know who is in control but ultimately you are in control of your own life. You grant these parasites their hand-outs every time you do business with them or use their form of currency.

You delegate the power to maim and mass murder by participating in the commercial realm. You may have heard about the recent "derivatives" scandal. What you will not be hearing about is that the bulk of the derivatives market is based on these presumed commercial obligations that most people are completely unaware of.

This root needs to be pulled up. More legislation is more likely to just give more power to the wrong people. We the people should take back our

power. We should take it back into the hands of folks who are much more likely to use it responsibly: You and I.

Chapter 7:

Banksters: What a Drag!

Have you considered the amount of education you could accumulate if you lived for two or three hundred years? Have you heard the tale of the frog and the boiling water? Our life-spans have been shortened by all the toxins we ingest. Some experts think the human body is capable of living up to 200 years or more. We all basically die of slow poisoning.

The FDA is consistently certifying "safe" levels of lab-altered chemicals in the mass food supply. If you're up to date on all the money-saving poisonous additives most corporations inundate our food with, you're aware that these greedy people controlling the corporations are selling off decades of our lives. When you sell millions of just one product, a penny saved is a dollar uptick on the stock market. If your customers die forty years later, it's pretty tough to prove you murdered them. If everyone is used to dying young and looking old, then nobody will be pointing any fingers.

Imagine the intellectual contributions of an Einstein or Tesla if they had an additional hundred years to continue their work? It would be pretty difficult to dumb us down if the geniuses in our society didn't die so shortly after making some of their greatest discoveries. Even when these discoveries are made, they are hoarded, sequestered and trickle out to the public, as soon as it's clear what is released will not effect current profit centers.

If we're on the same page and a lot of this is not new to you, have you ever pondered where mankind would be if we ever slipped our bankster leashes? Imagine what you could get accomplished if it cost nothing to travel across the country, world, or even universe? What if all your food was produced automatically? How long would you live, once the stress from basic survival management is eliminated?

It's a silent war on freedom. Nobody wants their freedom taken away. Do you think for one second your local black-cloaked thug-with-a-badge would be doing his job for any amount of money, if he knew he was selling his own children into slavery?

Would he go to work every day knowing that “just following orders” works only until his luck runs out, and he gets charged with the crimes he's committing every day? The answer of course is no.

War is fought against us on all fronts. We've been occupied by our neighbors, when you look at the modern day peace officer. Health care has been taken over by pharmaceutical corporations that bribe doctors to push drugs. Law has been subjugated by attorneys who intimidate you into waiving your rights so they can make a quick buck. Public schools have dumbed down people to the point they can barely figure out how to submit their straight-ticket vote, for a bunch of complete strangers. Banksters have a multitude of ways to steal from people who don't even know they're being robbed. Your neighborhood peace officers work long hours. They have enough time to perhaps flip on the TV for a half hour before bed every night in order to get informed. Maybe they pick up the lame stream news. Our neighbors are running the occupation of our country because they don't know the law. They only know how to follow orders. Present-day society is a form of soft martial-law.

It's big money to work in the servant-sector. On the average, social parasites make twice as much as productive members of society. The producers

in this country work twice as hard as those who live on taxation, fines, fees and red tape.

When one is making lots of money doing any job, they tend to get a bit protective about it. It's economically impossible to see any major reduction in crime due to the corresponding layoffs in public servants that would be the result. Public servants consistently invent new crimes in order to justify their jobs. Is it safe to say that every piece of legislation passed in congress has the goal of taking away someone's right simply by making them think they no longer have it?

Illegal quotas are demanded of supposed peace officers all over the country. These people are tasked with finding people to fleece for money under color of law. Instead of calling the cops when you need them, they're out looking for trouble on a regular basis. They commonly invent crimes where there is no injured party.

Liars on the witness stand are protected if they protect the bottom line, which means saying whatever it takes to make you pay. It doesn't matter what your word is because only the STATE's word matters. This fictional STATE

creature is foaming at the mouth for your money. If you don't pay or say the right magic words you will be beaten down. How is this different from the mafia or the mob?

Rarely does a peace officer meet a member of the public they have harmed in an off-duty setting. Peace officers rarely hang out with members of the general public as a rule. Police unions keep officers busy when they are not on duty with family events and regular social gatherings. Separation of the classes is complete. If it's necessary to shoot you one day for not following one of their policies, the PTB certainly don't want their foot soldiers to hesitate just because they recently had a few beers with you.

Rarely do servants seek their employment based on what they've read in the founding documents. More often than naught their goal is to achieve power to do virtually whatever they want. The biggest travesty of justice in America today is how it is extremely profitable to take away your liberty. The prison industry is swimming in available cash to lobby politicians for more and more jail-able offenses. Every dime the prison industry makes is debt. The advertisements from these corporations, wooing customers based on their low-cost labor are downright disgusting.

The national debt is mostly made up of prison bonds and other miscellaneous securities. These supposed obligations are created without the knowledge of anyone whose been bonded as a surety. When you hear these liabilities talked about on TV they are usually called “derivatives” to keep people completely in the dark about what's really going on.

Is That How It's Supposed To Work?

A King or Queen has servants. Servants perform jobs the noblemen don't want to do. At any time however, the Queen has the prerogative to give the servants the night off and cook a nice meal for her King. The King has the same prerogative when it comes to anything he has temporarily delegated off to his servants.

The Grand Canyon sized problem that you see in America today has evolved due to the proprietors (we the people) of our establishment (USA) haven't been minding the store. Instead we've been letting the servants do basically whatever they heck they want to do and most of us are completely ignoring them.

The only thing people in power seem to have to worry about is whether they'll be able to fudge the next election or not. The year these easily hackable electronic voting machines came out I stopped voting. Even though many of these machines provide no paper trail and recounts would be all but impossible, they were installed in election locations all over the country with barely a whimper from the public. I've since learned the votes supposedly recorded by these machines are not even counted in this country.

I can hear you now: "Hold on Vince, what about all this automation, streamlining and mass producing going on today? Shouldn't everything be getting cheaper?" Is it safe to say we really need to consider changing how we do just about everything?

When you apply this 60 time markup to land, farm animals, a tractor or materials for a barn it's apparent that the banksters have stolen our wealth and independence by pilfering the value of our generally accepted medium of exchange. It's a clever scheme. Over generations, our kingdoms have been conned away from us by replacing something of value with something people think has value. If the STATE controls the value of your "money," that's like putting your gold in a safe and giving your servant the combination, trusting he will never go in and grab your gold.

The cost of living in America is astronomical today. This slow burn on the economy is stealing the value of our labor. Today you must work to produce the resources for not just yourself but many others, in order to just keep your job. Doesn't it make more sense to just quit your job so you can start producing everything you need?

Imagine you are building a house all by yourself. It's slow going and it's going to be perhaps an entire year to complete the task working solo. One day 20 people show up to get your home raising done in a week. What if you could do the work of

many people? What if our labor credits had not been diluted to the point where one credit buys 60 times less than it did three generations ago? What would we be capable of in today's society?

Cutting your boss out of the equation by starting your own business is prohibitively expensive and time-consuming in order to do it "legally." Most Americans, even many with college degrees are forced to do whatever labor is available in order to find their next meal. Many forms of labor today in America are inherently unconstitutional. Most starving people will do anything to be able to feed themselves and their families. Our conversion to tyranny seems complete.

Through the course of the book in the footnotes you will notice I've done my best to define words in the clearest, most layman-available terms. The first thing you need in order to comprehend what's been done to you and your family is to decipher the words the STATE is attempting to use against you. The for-profit "court" system generally uses Black's Law, 5th edition for word definitions. A copy of this dictionary should be in every American home. The return to common law

and common sense can only be spearheaded by you and I. No BAR member will dare tip the apple cart, whether it be by understood threats against them if they did, or sheer greed.

Legalese is a different language than what you speak on the street. You've been raised up in public school to use all of these buzz words that get you into trouble with the legal industry. Keep in mind that "legal" does not necessarily mean "lawful." You can do lots of illegal stuff without breaking any laws.

For example: There is nothing in any of the founding documents which grants the servant-sector any power to regulate what people put into their bodies. The "War on Drugs" is completely unlawful yet somehow it has been made "legal." This is why there is an enormous difference between statutes and laws. If a politician put his John Hancock on a document which called this or that regulation a law, if that "law" was somehow unconstitutional, s/he would be guilty of treason.

Carl Miller has a series of three videos on YouTube which I highly recommend everyone watching. The first Supreme Court case he brings

up is *Marlbury vs Madison*, a decision which has been challenged over 100 times yet still stands, to support his assertion that anything in violation of the constitution is not a law. These unconstitutional statutes are null and void as such. They bear no power to enforce and convey no obligations upon you. The only way they can lawfully effect you is by your consent.

Traffic tickets, the IRS, court fees, property taxes, the BAR “requirement” to “represent” someone, and most licensing and registration would be unlawful if required by the STATE. Every single one of these systems are set up to bring in the profits. It's big business to make you think you lost your rights, that way they can be sold back to you at a premium.

In a nutshell, the war is waged against you by dumbing you down, therefore your best defense against the STATE is to educate yourself. Follow up on this information, it will lead you to a land of knowledge that will empower you. The feeling of knowing you can defend your rights without the help of an attorney, is as close to feeling free as you can get.

Many people think money is the key to their freedom so they do everything in their life based on the goal of making money. How many rich celebrities have we seen taken down by the legal industry? Shouldn't that evidence clearly show you that no amount of money can protect you from the forces of tyranny for very long? We must save "civilization" by becoming actual civilians, a conclusion which might seem to be in conflict with the title of this book.

Justice in today's for-profit "court" system is unattainable, unless you're willing to see through the smoke-screen and start bending some of these unlawful rules. The more you know about the law, the less you'll feel required to subject yourself to servitude.

The good news is you can fight back. The tools, technology and people are available to help you access the power that's been stolen from you under color of law. All you must do is start researching the subjects I've been presenting and everything will come together. People in these circles are usually very willing to bring in new recruits to the cause. The more the merrier,

because when the “100th monkey” has finally figured out the overall scam the rest of the public will fall in.

It doesn't take everyone who wakes up to put in their all for us to win. There's a ludicrous amount of energy being stolen from you based on every power you delegate to the servant-sector. Just one or two changes in your life such as closing a bank account or acknowledging your property deed can stem a huge income stream that's currently flowing into the war chest of the PTB.

Your war chest is probably very limited. That does not mean you are powerless in your quest to break the corporate matrix in your life. Just remember you are not required to do business with any corporation, regardless of it's name or perceived status in society. There are principal tenets which cannot be argued against which you can use as your guide in cleaning up the mess your servants have left for you. Now we're back to the importance of having our own code of honor. Let's break it down shall we?

Chapter 8:

Key to Self-Government: Honor

Common sense needs to become common again in our society. While researching all of the material for this book, your author found much of this information led to conclusions most would make, if only they would think things through.

It is common sense that if neither you or I are kicking and screaming, we're a lot less likely to attract the attention of the STATE. Kicking and screaming people need babysitters. After years of study I really can't blame the system. It is the lack of education about our responsibility as free people which is the root of the problem.

There are plenty of citizens that need to be looked after, but only because they do not realize how simple life is when one lives with honor. Do not harm others, steal or act in fraud, how long must one cram in order memorize the entirety of the code of honor? Given a choice of lists of rules to follow, when one peruses the UNITED STATES CODE, do I really need to finish this question?

You can be a king or queen even when you have no military force. All you must do is rule your kingdom with honor. An honorable man or woman is not going to find many objections to what they do from people other than rogue public servants. Honorable people are naturally sensitive toward the rights of others. If you are respecting people's rights and ignoring all the statutes, you're more likely to enjoy some peace and serenity provided you know the fundamental tenets of law.

Your acceptance of the rights of others builds a mutual respect for how you choose to exercise yours. A resolve to continue respecting the rights of others will get even the most stubborn friends and neighbors to come around to your way of thinking, sooner or later.

Do you live by the law of Karma? If so then you can easily learn the lesson of honor. "Do unto others" is not just a motto of common sense, it is also the best way to lead a peaceful life as free from outside control as possible. If you and I honor our private agreement there is no need for a third party to intervene. If you remain in honor I

need no outside force to govern you, by force, coercion or otherwise. Your word is as good as gold with me.

The current de-facto^{*42} ruling powers are much less likely to draw their sights on you if you can't be painted as potentially violent. If your reputation is solid due to many people know you, trust you and are willing to be your witnesses, that's the best protection you can have from the over-reaching hands of public servants.

No ruling force can stay in power for long if it cannot at least project the perception of honor, that includes you. The PTB currently running the show have lost their perception of honor with the people of this country. Everyone you talk to at the very least knows the servant-sector is corrupt beyond all recognition. We can't just point fingers however even if our own hands are clean, we also have to take responsibility for the solutions.

If it's difficult to call “the government” the “servant-sector,” consider that's because “servant”

42 A form of debt owed and used as “accounts receivable” to secure a further debt or obligation. Nobody in today's society ever actually “pays” for anything.

denotes a need to take responsibility for your servants who aren't doing their jobs. It would be nice if everyone just honored their oaths but since they don't, one of your capacities is going to have to be "supervisor of public servants" for the foreseeable future.

If you believe in freedom you should choose to be honorable in all of your dealings. If someone accuses you of doing wrong you need to do everything in your power to make amends if their accusation is valid. Denial and outright lying only invites the STATE into your private affairs. There is no conflict for a court or cop to decide if two individuals are honorable.

Self-government means that you have NO NEED to be governed, because you are rarely in conflict with others. Even when potential conflict seems inevitable you keep your cool, or cool down and de-escalate, rather than "go to war."

I frequently have to deal with the objection: "Are you saying you have the right to rape and murder?" Obviously a society where everyone has the freedom to do such things wouldn't feel very

free. People would be a bit jumpy and there would be more than a few itchy trigger-fingers.

God forbid we interpret the law for ourselves. We commit the horrible "crime" of "practicing law without a license." We file our own claims in courts of law, when at long last they can't be handled privately. At all times we remain in honor with our adversaries.

If we remain in honor with each other there is no need to give anyone else our power. Does that sound radical? Do we have a right to interpret the law to our benefit? Maybe we should ask a jury? Let's see if 12 people unanimously say we're not allowed to even attempt to read a book, if that book happens to be about law.

I must remind people that folks who believe in common law are not lawless, we must respect the rights of others or it's the one whose rights we've trampled upon we have to be concerned with. That is a natural law. If I harm you enough times sooner or later you're going to want to punch me in the nose.

Self-government is not a license to maim and murder. Hitler eventually fell from power by thinking he had the right to harm others. It is self-evident that nobody has the right to harm anyone other than themselves. If you try to harm me and think it is your right, you will quickly find that right taken away. I can confidently speak for most people when taking this position.

Honor is definitely not for the short-term minded. If one expects they should be rewarded at every interval for doing a righteous thing they're going to be frequently disappointed. Comprehending this paradox of human desire, is one of the keys to building the resolve it takes to walk the path of honor.

It's completely illogical to expect a reward every time we do something right yet many of us who've been sorely lacking in the approval department since we were born, have a hard time kicking the "expectation addiction."

The path of honor is a long, winding, twisting, turning road for which you're going to need to pack a lunch. You're not going to be instantly liked by a bunch of dishonorable people. They are

naturally going to resent you, unless you've been practicing hard to be a good politician.

The trouble in this world stems from a lack of honor in the general population. Expecting honor in return at all times is going to be a bit of a let down under present conditions. Many times you may feel like Christ himself as you are constantly crucified by others for doing not just the righteous thing, but the thing that makes the most freaking common sense.

You're unfortunately going to need to decide how much of a politician you want to be. No, I'm not talking about lying, cheating and stealing because that would be dishonorable. What I'm referring to is the learning curve that makes itself apparent when these common sense principles are understood, yet you can't seem to figure out why hardly anyone else is using them.

If we decide to unplug from the matrix, we better have a "New World" to migrate into. This is the world we are building. It's a world of self-governance, peace and abundance. The world of honor is a beautiful world. It's going to take some hard work to get there. If you've made it thus far

in this book, I'm betting you're one of the ones that isn't afraid of a little hard work.

Chapter 9:

Who Can You Trust?

It doesn't matter how much time you spend researching your vote, because ultimately there is an army of people around each politician doing their best to make sure their guy or gal looks and sounds perfect. The ones who win, are the ones who pull-off the best deception.

I can identify with someone who makes mistakes. I can also identify with people who think they are perfect, even though I know perfection is unattainable. We talk about potential presidents, sheriffs and representatives, but what we don't think about is what a leader's job actually is. Many feel a leader should know everything and never make a mistake.

We were born to make mistakes. Rules were made to be broken and all that jazz. Why does the totally illogical tend to make so much sense to so many people every election season? If I did vote again, I would be voting for the most down-to-earth candidate with the less-than-perfect past, that's

likely to be the more honest one. Robin Williams portrayal of Tom Dobbs in the fictional movie "Man of the Year," is exactly what I am talking about. This is the guy or gal who typically gets around two percent of the vote. Isn't expecting this two percent to change in your lifetime totally illogical?

In the activism community we are inundated by "paytriots" as well as plants¹ from the establishment. If someone is leading something and they've got more than a few nickles to rub together, there's about a coin-flip chance that he or she is legit. There are unfortunately people who will do anything to get their hands on power, including exploiting good folks who just want to restore freedom in this country.

Do you trust me? Unless you've met me and known me for at least a short while I hope the answer is no. I would expect most intelligent people to follow up on this information before accepting any of it as fact. When I ask a general question of people not in the loop about whether they can trust the servant-sector or not many people surprisingly say yes. I then ask them if they

trust me. Most say no because they don't know me. I don't take offense, I simply point out they don't really know most of their servants either.

The willingness of people to trust the STATE violates all logic. Where before the man was the disciplinarian of the family, now most divorced single mothers leave that up to the STATE. The STATE now replaces the man in many families and the TV handles the education/programming.

The STATE is invited to intrude into every facet of a family's lives thanks to legal processes like custody battles. Since people in this situation are usually pretty emotional, they never consider the effects of their willingness to allow the STATE to handle their affairs. Awesome power is granted to the STATE due to emotional instability.

Families today are more divided than perhaps any time in history. My own family has been ripped apart due to our separate beliefs regarding what it is the STATE can and can't do to us. If there's no trust there's no love. If there is no love then people are more apt to be alone with nobody else to turn to except the STATE.

Marriage is one of the most dishonored contracts in present day society. The STATE is always willing to step in when people can't get along. How did our parents or grandparents ever think it was acceptable to have to ask permission to get married? Shouldn't the only people needing to ask permission be minors? Shouldn't the only people needing to grant permission to marry be their parents? How did we let the STATE get involved in these affairs of the heart? Does the STATE have any capacity to love?

It's easy in this current world of scarcity to get screwed over. We live in a cut-throat system. Everyone is looking for the best deal because so many people are just-over-broke. Scarcity drives prices up and quality down. It's much easier for corporations to make a buck if they control a large portion of the market. Next time you go to the supermarket take note of how many different brands of each item are available. Multi-national corporations have already cornered the market on almost everything you buy.

People are hungry. Few have reliable living-wage type work. Massive corporations program the

general public that “illegal aliens” must stay “illegal” so that stockholders can continue to be paid big dollars, that aren't being paid to these hard working folks making well below the minimum wage.

We the people are fighting over what table scraps we're “permitted” to have, while fat-cats we voted for give away the public coffers to their buddies who paid for all the votes. If you haven't bought your local politician, chances are they're not beholden to you.

The system is imploding. Why do we continue to support it by “voting” for people we can supposedly trust to defend the constitution? Why don't we just fire all of our servants and instead govern ourselves without interference? I know I can do it. I'm sure you believe you can do it. Now we just have to convince you that everyone else can do it too, and yes I know that's a tough sell for some people.

I trust myself. The list of people I trust has increased in recent years due to my mobile lifestyle. I frequently move on to new places and meet new people. I believe the value of finding

someone I can trust is much higher than anything I can materiality possess. Someone I trust will bend over backwards to help me if need be, inasmuch as I'd do the same for them.

People who are financially centered are suspect. People driven by financial goals tend to not care much about other people or the big picture. I've found in recent years I've lost the care for money outside of my basic living needs, which I'm consistently working to eliminate through self-sufficiency. Living outside of the FEDERAL SLAVE SYSTEM is sometimes inconvenient, but I'm patient and I can wait out the banksters. I'm not going to allow my energy to be used for evil.

“Money” really is the “root of all evil.” The reason is because when people are thinking of money they aren't usually thinking about anything else. Those who are spiritually centered are still selfish individuals, they just have a much broader view about what is good for them. A world where everyone has an abundance is what we're working towards. In a world like that there is no need for money. That's what your author is working

towards. I am convinced a world like that would be better for me.

I get a kick out of folks who say "that guy is totally self-centered" because I don't know who else I'm supposed to center myself on. We're all selfish. The question is are you narrow-minded or not? I'm not Mother Teresa anymore than I think the actual woman was the idol she came to be. There are rumors that Jesus Christ was someone who never wanted to be worshiped, he was just trying to teach some common sense.

People who do good things believe generally in the laws of karma. I believe the more good energy I put out into the world, the more good energy I'll get back. Sometimes it takes a bit of patience to see the results of this theory but when it pays off, it does so in spades.

Just Follow the Leader

In the commercial sector, everyone wants to join something. In the private sector people are usually adverse to participation, and would rather do their own thing. This is our "achillie's heel" in the liberty movement.

Let's take this a different way. Imagine the fruits of your labor as part of a "well-oiled" team of people, of like mind, for just one year? Wouldn't that liberty you're searching for be much more attainable, after one year of service to a common cause?

There are plenty of people out there who want to be leaders. There are far less who are willing to follow any one or thing but "money." Our desire to stay independent is ironically one of our biggest hurdles to overcome when it comes to cooperating with each other in our opposition to the STATE and all of it's never-granted powers.

If you know a leader you can trust, follow him even though he may make mistakes. It's okay to be smarter or have more useful skills than your leader. What's important for any organization is that you have a "point man" who can coordinate your efforts, and streamline your goals. Consistency is much more important than abilities for the long-term success of your organization, when it comes to whom you choose.

A good leader should admit his mistakes. Leaders are not always calling the shots, instead the very

best are asking their followers what to do. Effective leaders consistently crave feedback, with the intention of improving their performance. Two heads are better than one. Anyone who does not listen to others I could never consider a leader, because their sphere of education is so limited, they only listen to themselves.

The reason I bring up this topic in this chapter is because there are many people out there who no longer trust the corporate “news” outlets due to all the evidence they're being lied to, yet they are willing to blindly trust someone new in the freedom movement if they've got a slick website. They're also willing to jack open their wallet for the latest legal scam they don't even comprehend.

With enough verification of a leader's claims on a consistent basis you can feel confident in trusting him or her. Most do no verification at all before jumping on the bandwagon of every Tom, Dick and Harry who come along promising the next magic bullet system for regaining their freedom. The truth about freedom is in order to get it, it's going to take you learning about the law and

knowing how to defend your rights, on cue. In that task, only you can be the leader.

In order to ensure the servants stay out of your private affairs, it's going to take on the average 5-7 people you can trust, and sometimes lean on when the going gets tough. For example when you visit the county clerk to drop off some documents, having a couple of witnesses with you can prove invaluable. If you feel you must go to court, witnesses able to confirm a magistrate has violated his oath can spell the end of your aggravation.

If you are visited by an unruly peace officer, having a couple of people nearby who are willing to come to your aid as witnesses will always put the cop in the hot seat. If you have someone you can call when pulled over and can say to the officer "I've been advised not to speak, you may speak to my counsel" you've now put an enormous roadblock up in front of his road-side interrogation.

You need people you can trust around you if you are going to make the full switch to self-government. It is very difficult to do this alone. Many of us have done this alone in the past, but it

doesn't have to be that way today. If you have a solid team to work with, it can wind up being much easier.

All we have to do is support each other. Supporting me supports you. Why can't most people see that? The answer is because there is a lack of trust. You may not know who I am. Perhaps you've never even met me. How can you possibly support me based upon those conditions? What exactly do you have to lose however if you did trust me? What could you potentially gain by having a bit of faith and patience? The fear of loss, beaten into us by life over the last few generations, has made it quite difficult to see the upside of any given situation.

The only individuals able to amass major support it seems are the ones with deep pockets. Are these the people we should trust? How much does a billionaire really care about you and everyone like you? If this billionaire owns a TV network, do you think he'll broadcast information that assists you up and out of your abject poverty? Really?

The key to this dilemma is to re-evaluate the value of finding people we can trust. We should reset

our goals to prioritize finding a network of like-minded folks who can support our cause and help us succeed. As Ron Paul says: "Freedom is popular." It's not hard to find people who believe in freedom. The people we find must learn the value of tollerating the freedom of others.

Chapter 10:

Your Word is Your Bond

Over the years during my law research I've been made aware of several sayings that seemed to be like clues leading me to the truth. Your word is bonded in one of these administrative proceedings people think are courts of law. What that means is you're authorizing securities, debts and obligations being traded in the ALL CAP franchise name you're presumed to be a representative of.

Okay now that's crazy talk. What did he say? Most make the mistake of thinking their name when spelled in ALL CAPITAL LETTERS has the same legal meaning as their own grammar-school taught name in upper and lower case. Let me simplify this for you: Is a woman named "Cat" the same as a your furry feline friend?

For those of you thinking this is "patriot nonsense" get yourself a good magnifying glass and take a look at the signature line of one of your checks under some good lighting. You'll notice with the naked eye it's a bit fuzzy, or a little more

gray than the other lines. It's actually not a line at all! On most checks it will say something like "authorized representative" over and over. Why would "they" want to hide this information in near-microscopically fine print?

Isn't it logical to presume someone does not want you to know you've been tricked into representing a corporate franchise? Do you remember anything about being an "authorized representative" of yourself in public school? How can you re-present yourself if you are yourself, isn't that a bit redundant? Wouldn't you just present yourself in court if you're speaking on your own behalf? Why do these "courts" ask us if we want to re-present² ourselves?

You're being treated as an employee of one of their corporations instead of the CEO of your own! As an employee you're subject to the rules, you don't make them. You haven't decided to take control of your own company because you didn't know you had one. Your "legal name" identifies your subsidiary of a dead-beat busted corporation that is so far in-debt to the people they can never be repaid.

Ask yourself if in America every single man, woman and child born here should be required to have some sort of financial obligation to a corporate entity, or is it logical to assume that our War for Independence won us the freedom to not be forced into servitude to such insensitive masters?

When you start asking “authorities” important questions with respect to your rights nowadays they are being trained to automatically think you are a terrorist. The money changers are so desperate now they are actually trying to make the constitution a bad word. Their fraudulent debt-bond based system is coming apart at the seams due to evidence of this fraud leaking out all over the internet.

The “old guard” is bleeding like a stuck pig and squealing about it just as much. We're winning.

The question arises when considering the inevitable collapse of the for-profit “court” system: What do we replace it with? Do we need to place people in power over us? Do you need another

daddy, mommy or school-yard bully? Forget about age because age is irrelevant to this next question: Are you an adult? Are you capable of understanding that it's wrong to harm someone else?

Everyone I ask answers "yes" to that last question, but many of those same people then start worrying about what others would do with their freedom if they were educated about their rights and could assert those rights effectively. This line of thought is a dead-end. We are our own tyrants. Judge not lest ye be judged. The need to control others is inherently communistic in nature. If you look around at the control issues out there today it's no wonder the USA has, without exaggeration, become the USSA especially in the last 30 or so years.

There is also very limited motivation to help anyone but numero uno. It's an interesting paradox. Lots of people want freedom for themselves and slavery for everyone else. Instead of giving someone a hand-up and out of their financial wasteland, the majority would rather direct them to some "social services" program. We

need to learn about freedom. Freedom means not only having the liberty to live life as we please, it's also about developing the self-sufficiency to not be dependent on anyone but ourselves.

Most importantly on the topic of your word being your bond, if you don't know what it is you are saying how can you have any idea what it is you're agreeing to? Court systems are supposed to conduct themselves according to intent, they're not supposed to be based on literal interpretations when clearly people speaking on their own behalf are not having their intentions respected.

If you say something and hence agree to something as far as the other party is concerned, is it the other party's responsibility to confirm your precise intent once your signature is on the contract? The answer to this question according to basic contract law is yes, but how else can one confirm that intent unless precise legal language is used? Is it reasonable to presume that once you have said "I agree" that this other party, even though they knew you did not know what you were doing, is legally in the clear?

Knowledge of a contract is not a zero-sum game. If I were to cleverly write in legalese something which seems harmless yet winds up being a major problem for you later on, even though you know I knew I was "pulling the wool over your eyes," how in God's name are you to prove that I knew you didn't know? This is how the PTB can dupe a dumbed down society until they are basically slaves on a really nice plantation.

Today the slaves have toilets, electricity, HDTV and running water, but most are virtual prisoners in their homes due to the lack of financial ability to even go out to dinner.

Am I crazy, or are you beginning to see how the "slave" analogy fits? If you're totally honest with yourself, would you admit or agree that you've been tricked into thinking you were free, only for the purpose of making you a well-trained, specialized tax slave, able to rake in obscene profits for your fictional corporate masters?

A Tale of Two Societies

Globally, commerce is governed by the Uniform Commercial Code. It is effectively a world

government. The main point to remember, is that your freedom can be restored by removing yourself from these voidable contracts you now find yourself presumed to be subject to.

One society has consented to be governed by whoever wins whatever election and granted "jurisdiction" over certain service areas. This society is administered by a group of individuals who have taken oaths to uphold and defend the constitution which includes the Bill of Rights. The people in this society have waived guaranteed rights in return for McDonald-Land granted privileges. These "civil rights" come with the obligation to obey the rules legislated by those who govern.

This is a society of order-followers, from the housewife on up to the President of the United States. Nobody thinks much, or even has time to articulate their perspective on the reality they live in. They are all part of the matrix. It is a matrix of distractions, fiat currency and the drive for material possessions.

The veil has been pulled firmly over the eyes of those not pulling the strings. A super-majority are

horribly uninformed about what's really going on. Few wake up from this kind of slumber. From the time of "birth" these "citizens" have lived in a Pavlovian world, where everyone is trained to march to just the right drummer.

It's our own ignorance, planned perhaps by very rich, self-interested predators of society, yes but still each of us has had the responsibility and obligation to keep people who naturally want to grab more power, in check. Have we exercised our power? Can I hammer home the solution to this problem any clearer? Hopefully I don't have to spell it out for you but just to hear me say it:

Chapter 11:

The Solution Is You

If you've done any complaining about how things are going: In a free country, whose responsibility is it to make sure things run smoothly? If you are the king of your castle, then who runs your kingdom?

Either you are royalty as "one of the people," or you have volunteered to be somebody's servant. There is no middle class here in America, contrary to popular belief. Once you know how the system works and you capitulate to fear, you've chosen servitude. Instead you should be asking your servant/would-be oppressor what law grants him the power to violate your rights.

It's Up to Us!

What are you willing to do? I wrote a book compiling much of what I've learned over the years so you and many others can use this education as a stepping-stone to greater knowledge. Later on in this chapter I will be

detailing a very specific plan I have to change the world by introducing a well run barter/trading society with its foundation rooted in the rules of honor, complete with its own private credit system, alternatively even exchangeable with BitCoin and other popular online currencies, that is if you aren't already changing the world on your own of course!

If you're still reading, you must be willing to do something. A soldier is willing to go to a distant land and kill people when he doesn't even understand their language. He's willing to give his life if it becomes necessary, in the name of "freedom."

A hardcore activist confronts the most well-armed and trained security force on the planet, in most cases unarmed. Once tossed in a cage, one's life savings can be pilfered in legal expenses while they are held hostage. Who has the riskier job? Who needs to be more brave in order to do that job on a daily basis?

The job of being an activist was much more difficult twenty years ago. Today, instead of having our asses handed to us on a regular basis,

we are racking up wins. Die hard patriots in the field are starting intimidate rogue public servants, instead of the other way around. You won't get this breaking news from the "lame stream" media. The banksters don't want all the rogue peace officers currently doing their bidding to wake up and realize they are acting outside of their delegated powers. You now see these criminals get prison time for excessive use of force, among other treasonous crimes.

The only reason we are being pushed around by our servants is because we are not holding them to their words of honor. If we must stumble through the court system in order to figure out how it works, then so be it. Much of the ground work has been laid out to begin your education in law. Call-in talk shows with knowledgeable guests like Angela Stark's "My Private Audio" have been "airing" online for years to show you how you can grant yourself the power you never knew you had.⁴³ This former activist turned law study, has decided the answer lies far beyond attempting to reform any presumed "courts of law."

43 Click heels three times!

When you know what your rights are and how to peacefully assert them, staying free becomes natural. When you know you are right, instead of "disobedient," the entire outlook of every situation will change. The self-confidence you will gain in dealing with public servants will be enormous after your first win in court, which is usually in the form of never being contacted again. The vindication you will feel after asking some power-tripping wanna-be overlord questions that he has to directly answer, on a witness stand, could not possibly be quantified, but it would make you invincible the next time a public servant wants to call your bluff. Too many of us have bluffed too many times for far too long and that's why we're where we are. In your author's opinion however, if you're in court, it is only because of your lack of preparation in dealing with public servants.

When you first start exercising them for real, it's a lot of work to stand up for your rights. Sometimes it's a lot of paperwork. Sometimes if you're as committed as some of us, you might be needing first aid!

It wouldn't be so much work if public servants honored their oaths of office, but keep in mind the reality that we're making up for over a hundred years of self-education negligence. Each one of us has had the power to hold a public servant accountable all by ourselves, if only we had the knowledge. Let's face it though, the reason we're in this position is because we've just been too lazy, too busy or just plain didn't feel like being well-informed.

No Deposit, No Return

You must withdraw your participation and hence financial support for these "services" that are limiting your liberty. As free people, we need to opt-out of all these services which expose our privacy to those who would use that energy to do us harm. I know this is common sense, but the general population can't see the big picture.

Can't Sever the Umbilical Cord?

The tools are now available to break free of the bankster matrix. 5 years ago it was a nightmarish privacy-waiver to do any business online. Today you can start collecting "same as cash" payments

in the time it takes to set up an email account. Thanks to exciting new breakthroughs in cryptocurrencies you can even do business and send payments anonymously, globally and instantly.

These new breakthroughs can protect your right to do business without interference from others. Don't procrastinate! Start utilizing these new technologies that protect your rights, right now.

Like most solutions to our SLAVE NOTE debt system mess, this one is not cost-prohibitive. The cost of doing business in virtual currency is so close to free it's not even worth mentioning. How much has your bank charged you to keep track of what kind of light bulbs you've been buying all these years?

BitCrimeCoin?

The enemies of freedom are hard at work doing everything they can to keep the future from happening such as putting out bad press about private online currencies. Stories such as the drug-site bust of "Silk Road," saturate all public channels, making people think if they're caught with some Bitcoin they go to jail.

You can within days set up a barter system in your local community to get as many of your needs met as possible. During a disaster scenario you might have only a few hours. A weather broadcast of two inches of snow in an area where people aren't generally used to it usually empties the store shelves and causes at best a slight panic to grab a couple weeks worth of extra food.

Don't re-invent the wheel, search the local classifieds to see if anyone else is thinking the same thing. An efficient local barter system is a stepping stone to becoming completely independent. Your goal is to eventually be depositing zero energy into the old world of scarcity, and all of your energy into a "New World Order" of abundance!

Every time you can complete a transaction without letting the banksters get a cut is a win for your rights. One "band-aid" type pre-solution is where you just stop using banks and start paying cash for everything. If your cash never sees a bank, the banksters can't get their un-earned share. Ultimately we must stop using their source of near-infinite power, the "dollar bill," a debt for a

dollar, otherwise known as the FEDERAL RESERVE NOTE.

We have been conned into believing that resources are scarce and hence "much more expensive" when what's really happened is our medium of exchange has been reduced to the point where it has a negative value.

Cash Poor, Stuff Rich?

One day I knock on your door and after a friendly greeting and casual chat I bring up my "Abundance Club" and hand you a list. Peanut butter, cucumbers, tomatoes, pasta, tilapia, hay and a few other items are available to you from our club, for free, there's just one catch.

Next I hand you another list and inform you that all you must do to receive an abundance of everything in our club is pick something off our list that we need, or feel free to suggest what we haven't thought of, which you would be happy to provide.

You can grow one or two vegetables or fruits in abundance and then put out a "free watermelon"

sign in front of your house with an asterisk by the large print. Then in fine print below put "some conditions apply." People are going to want to know the conditions you require in order to get some free stuff so they will stop by and talk to you.

The only condition is they must grow some vegetable in abundance you can have for free whenever you want within reason. Most will probably not already be growing their vegetables so you could give them some of yours on credit, the first time it's the neighborly thing to do anyway.

The next time they come by for watermelon they must have already had you over to inspect that they are in fact growing what they said they would be growing. This would be another up-front condition they agreed to when getting their first couple of vegetables from your garden.

Of course people can only take what they need for their own immediate family or household. You can't take the chairs I made for your kitchen table and go trade them for SLAVE NOTES. Cheating the club would be highly dishonorable and

grounds for immediate termination of membership.

With the new discoveries in aquaponics and limited space grow rooms, there's no reason everyone can't grow whatever they want on a very limited budget in vast quantities. There are hundreds of videos online showing all different types of aquaponics systems. The basic design is quite easy to put into operation and could be set up in a couple of days.

After a bit of research on advanced grow methods, ask yourself how easy it would be to produce an abundance of tomatoes, cucumbers or hay for perhaps two dozen people? Is that work worth eliminating the need to either produce or somehow procure the other 23 items available, in abundance, to club members?

Hydroponic grow towers are a great way to grow 10 times the food in the same square foot. Towers can be put together with plastic bottles, PVC pipe or whatever you have lying around.

The contacts that will be gained by putting a "free veggies" sign on your lawn will be exponential.

Remember to get people's contact information as soon as you meet them and keep that list well organized.

I recently had to come up with a solution for having no phone and only communicate through email or chat . The man who had just loaned me a hose to fill my water barrel at the local well was someone who didn't use the internet and only had a phone but was interested in my new project. Some information mined at a previous time came in handy, because I did not have a phone, but I could email his phone in the form of a text message.

You can send anyone an email to their phone as a text message. All you need to know are the phone number and their phone carrier. A quick search on the internet will show you how to format your party's phone-email address. Don't give up if you are limited on connectivity. Where there's a will to get your community organized, there's a way.

You can put that phone-email address on your business cards, too. Make a note that your email is a "text message box" so people using regular email will know they need to keep it short and sweet.

I'm not a big fan of marches or protests. The only thing that usually gets accomplished by those events is to get freedom loving people put on terrorist watch lists, or tied up in a resource draining "legal" system.

While I respect and admire those of us who put their face and name on the line with the intent of increasing their audience and ability to educate, we must start duplicating our leadership qualities, instead of trying to lead herds of followers who can easily be led astray.

You must lead you or as "a people" we will never have freedom. I and others like me will just have to deal with an irrational amount of aggravation every time we deal with public servants who have never had their "God complexes" put in check during the course of their entire careers.

No man or woman once educated about their rights can be turned away from the self-evident truth which defining freedom for themselves can unveil. They can make excuses, and justify their actions but ultimately everyone needs to believe somewhere in their soul that what they are doing is right. Even if it's wrong and they are "just

following orders” somewhere in their brain something is making what they are doing okay .

The quickest, easiest and most passive way to make a change is by refusing to contract (do business) with corporations that chip away at your rights, for profit. This includes even the corporations slick enough to be named after countries.

If it wasn't so horrific I'd have to chuckle at the irony when thinking of the penalty for impersonating a peace officer, these corporations are impersonating entire countries and getting away with mass murder!

Above all if you know who you are and have a firm grasp of what self-evident rights are all about, you're now keen to the fact in law that we're all equal. At this point, hopefully anyone who is a novice has been doing some follow up research as they've been following along in this book. It should be confusing to you at this point when anyone comes along and presumes they have some type of authority over you. I hate to sound like a broken record, but servants have no authority. They are granted powers which were

delegated to them by the people. This delegated power to manage your affairs can be revoked by you at any time on an unconditional basis. Now that your head is on straight, questions like these will fire out of your brain as if they were on autopilot:

- ❖ *“Okay now first of all who are you?”*
- ❖ *“Do you have any identification?”*
- ❖ *“What is your bond number?”*
- ❖ *“As a public servant you are legally required to be bonded against public harm. Are you bonded sir/ma’am?”*
- ❖ *“Without this information I’m afraid I can’t verify you are part of the servant-sector in any way. I can’t just take the word of every complete stranger that comes knocking on my door wanting information from me. Good day sir/ma’am. Please come back when you have a warrant, otherwise you will be guilty of trespass.”*

I think you get the point. The people possess an incredible amount of power to protect their liberty, they just don't exercise it. The adept at guarding their liberty have pre-written notices right by the door in order to hand out to anyone claiming to be "working for the government."

If you are physically forced to comply or intimidated to the point of capitulation, you can at least comply "under duress" and also sign "under duress" which makes your compliance involuntary. If they will not let you write "under duress" you can also put "u.d." as if they were your initials, it means the same thing. Eventually the people you are dealing with should get the message, however some folks are too drunk on their perceived power.

One of the fundamental requirements in a valid contract is knowledge of the terms. If you don't know the terms and don't tell anyone you don't know, you're presumed to know. These contracts remain legally valid until you speak up, preferably in writing, notarized and certified. The public notary you use will have a certification filed with either the state or the county. Ideally you can even

create your own seal, otherwise use your "signature" and instead of calling it that, by your autograph call it a "seal." Your seal can be whatever you want. This document with three seals now becomes a "Public Act" as referenced in the constitution. It can be recorded as such with your local county recorder.

Mainly the goal of this low-risk passive resistance is to make notice to whoever is noticing you. Make them aware of your non-consent to their process while at the same time starting your own process. All of their admissions can be made by omission, in your favor before you ever walk into a court room. Use the tools they are using against you, against them, and then march into a court and file your claim if need be. Don't make threats. Follow through if you tell some rouge agent you're going to sue, better yet "walk softly but carry a big stick." Resistance is less painful that way.

Even if it's just one page in layman's terms that your rights have been violated, file a case into your local court and get the ball rolling. You have to stumble before you walk, if you're in a hurry to get where you're going.

If you need to ask questions about about the legal process and get the “we don't give out legal advice” response simply tell them you are not asking for advice, you are inquiring as to what is the proper procedure and is that information only available to licensed BAR attorneys?

As the forces of freedom have grown stronger and made massive advances, our enemies have done their best to counter. Organizations like SPLC, the FBI and DHS are spending millions of dollars spamming the public with libelous remarks regarding anyone who has picked up a Bill of Rights and started reading it. One bad apple in the bunch who thinks it's okay to kill someone whose casually violating his rights becomes the poster boy for our entire movement.

The purpose of the above paragraph is to prepare you for the programming your neighborhood peace officer has been subjected to. If you even say the word “constitution” s/he's been trained to think you're dangerous and will likely shoot you if you make any quick movements. Do not raise your voice and continue to ask questions. Do not

answer any questions “without a lawyer present.”
The one who is as-KING questions is in control.

Making your statements “under penalty of perjury” is a trump card when dealing with rouge public servants. The caveat here is your adversary will never take responsibility, they will always defer to “company policy” and will not swear to anything under threat of imprisonment if they are lying or misinformed. Their answer, not under any type of oath or affirmation is prima facie evidence proving they have no intention of making any statement that could be used in a court of law.

If you are not a fan of the IRS yet still fear retaliation if you dare to defy them, you can still fill out your forms and anything you wind up “owing” you can instead drop into some type of investment. Leave it there growing just in case the IRS decides to confront you for not filing your taxes. If they never come calling the money you would have given away to parasites becomes your retirement fund, freeing you of dependence on socialist security.

If the IRS contacts you, you are perfectly justified in clarifying the definitions of the words they are

using when corresponding with you. In Black's Law, 5th edition, "income" is defined as "money" and the definition of money excludes "notes." Isn't that piece of paper you use as money called a "note?" A note is an obligation or debt. It is not money.

Does anyone who gets paid in "FEDERAL RESERVE NOTES" ever make "money?" Can you have income if you never make money? Look up the definition of "income" to find out!

Write the IRS a letter asking them a simple question. Address it to someone specifically who has corresponded to you and has apparently made some claims you find objectionable. Ask this agent who has presumed you made "income," what definition of that word they are using. A corporation only "exists" on paper or in your imagination. You can't fight a corporation because you can do no actual harm. Instead pick your battle with that one man or woman who is attempting to boss you around when they have no right to do so.

Provide the definitions of "income" and "money" in the letter to clarify their terminology as you

understand it. You could lawfully state that you have no income yet the key is to not make any claims at all. The objective when responding is to make the other party prove their claims. The IRS is claiming you have income. Sometimes it's as easy as asking them "Are you claiming I have income?" Let's recap: The one as-KING questions is king or queen.

Once you have filled out the forms, signed them and forwarded them to the IRS, if you claimed any income you have PERJURED YOURSELF. How many millions of Americans commit perjury every year at tax time?

Every time you spend a dollar bill you give "full faith and credit" to that bill and you create more debt. Our good intentions alone back these "dollar bills" which banksters can print "out of thin air," while the rest of us have to slave for them.

I've heard many times how the "government prints money out of thin air" while this is factually incorrect. Our servant-sector actually prints up DEBT out of thin air, which anyone can do. Consider I write you a check for \$1,000. Once you have endorsed the check proving your acceptance

of my “promise to pay,” we've created a debt proverbially out of “thin air.”

Now let's compound the problem of the current monetary system by telling you all banksters are outright thieves. They are stealing your wealth every time a withdrawal is made, for whatever reason, from your account.

The “FEDERAL RESERVE NOTE” you have in your pocket is not a “dollar,” it is instead a “dollar bill.” It is a bill for a dollar. You are paying your debts with debts. No wonder the National Debt number keeps rising and rising!

Now let's refer back to our example of my \$1,000 check. When you take it to a “bank” you are exchanging a \$1,000 debt for 1,000 notes of debt. This is an equal exchange. It's a done deal. You and I created this debt out of thin air which everyone uses as a medium of exchange. These debt notes are then used as spendable credits.

The theft happens when the banksters make a withdrawal of 1,000 of these imaginary credits from my account. You and I created the 1,000 “credits” by creating a \$1,000 valid debt. A debit

to my previous balance is theft because it's completely unrelated to our transaction.

Everyone is creating "credits" however the only ones withdrawing any credits from this monetary matrix are the banksters.

Imagine what the established society would look like now if everyone knew this three generations ago? Bank accounts would increase to infinity and "money" would become obsolete once each of these rich people achieved their resource-independence. Instead greed led the banksters to keep this secret to themselves and infinite wealth is stolen from us on a daily basis.

In the movie "the matrix" NEO touches the mirror and finds himself sucked inside. I believe this is an analogy demonstrating how we went from a credit-based money system to a debt-based slave system of hopes and dreams. We've been living on the "back side of the mirror" since we were born.

We have the banksters on the run now. As the tale goes the only time Jesus got angry was when he was dealing with the money changers. Alternative currencies and the power of the internet are going

to free mankind from these cannibalistic parasites once and for all.

If you're still intent on complying with this kleptocracy and you've been "charged" with a misdemeanor, you can just pack up and move to another state. You can't be extradited even by commercial regulation unless you're facing a felony. This is a great loophole in commercial codes for those of you who would like to stay in commerce, yet wish to move to "more free" STATES.

We've allowed this monster to crop up all around us, using us as it's gears and levers. The quickest way to pull the plug would be for each of us to change our names, move and leave no forwarding "address." That was a really nice daydream I just had.

I myself lean toward the "do or die" decisions for the most part in my life provided they do not risk my liberty. I've done my time in the trenches where I've been beaten and kidnapped multiple times for no good reason. Resistance is not futile but it has become a bit of a fine art in today's post Patriot Act society.

If you don't want to be physically harmed while conducting your activism the only way I know how to do that is by learning the law and being prepared to get dragged in front of a guy/gal in a black robe. Once you are confident you can get yourself out of that situation, your fear of the rogue peace officer who just pulled you over will subside. If you know your stuff feel free to tell it like it is to this supposed agent of "law enforcement" who claims to know the law. Once he steps over the line you can comply "under duress" stating "You are free to cuff me if you don't mind me filing a claim for kidnapping and treason."

If you don't mind being arrested there is no need to escalate your interaction to violence. Once you've decided the servant you're dealing with is not going to get off his or her power-trip just say "I'm done dealing with you because this is against my will, if you don't like that then arrest me but I assure you it will be at your own legal peril."

Preparation is key for the activist who wants to be able to win that confrontation at the side of the road. I have a two page document I created from

scratch which explains in the simplest terms possible my understanding of the law and also that they are breaking the law just by pulling me over. I have a right to travel unencumbered, absent any evidence that I'm operating in the land of commerce using a commercial vehicle.

Commerce is essentially buying AND selling without necessarily adding any value to the product. If you grow tomatoes and sell them that is not technically commerce. One reasonable exception would be if you regularly use the roads to deliver them. If you depend on the road to be in service to run a profitable business it's self-evident that you should pitch in for road maintenance in order to keep the profits rolling in, and hence that is how the constitution is set up.

Bring That Hammer Down!

This section is for those of you who want to just rip off the band-aid instead of peeling it off real slow. You're ready to pull the plug on "the matrix" that is feeding off your life force. The goal is to starve it off so the lights fade, go dim and it

runs out of power. It will cease to exist once we the people self-govern again and hence put it out of business.

The best solution to any problem is to “teach a man to fish.” Knowing your rights and refusing to waive them while educating others one at a time is ultimately for all of us the best way to go. Getting bogged down in someone else’s “legal” troubles is definitely not the most effective use of your time. Education is the solution to our information-deprived servitude. Teach those around you how to assert their rights, without the help of anyone else. Show them simple things about the law which you’ve learned that you clearly understand.

I'm a complete outcast of this present society and I'm fine with it. I've finally taken to heart the old adage regarding insanity and being “well adjusted to a sick society.” I want to find a “Galt's Gultch ” and who knows, by the time you read this I may have found one or at the very least started it (wink).

Moving, Dodging and Weaving Targets

Nothing this author suggests should be construed to mean you should sit and rot in jail. That's definitely not a good plan anymore. There are too many former leaders of this freedom movement that are rotting away in jail. They sit and wait for those of us who haven't got ourselves caged to learn what we need to know in order to free them peacefully, or to one day find another way.

Odds are you and I are in the same financial boat. If the bankster system collapsed most of us would be out a few hundred dollars. The trip to zero for our current tyrants would be complete pandemonium to the point many of them would be taking swan dives out of their high-rise office windows.

Being an effective activist requires knowing what battles you can choose not to fight and focusing on the ones that are the highest priority. Check your liabilities and defenses. Are you fortified well? Are you able to dodge and weave, or are you just going to stand there outside your front door and wait for the steamroller to come?

I'm the "traveling carpenter" as I've decided anything rooted securely to a piece of dirt can't possibly be considered mine for very long. We have standing armies in every town and city who "just follow orders" and when you get evicted from your home which you supposedly own, you'll get my meaning (or maybe you already have).

If you don't have an army you have no hope of defending your castle so you basically have two choices: Buy a home on wheels or keep your head down and pay the local magistrate whatever he wants in taxes, fines, fees, your time and lots of red tape so you can be left in relative "safety." You can't stay on point with your message if you can't just get going, when the going gets tough.

The hacktivist group "Anonymous" has it all figured out when it comes to free speech. If the tyrants can physically get their hands on you, you don't have free speech. If you're anonymous you can say whatever you want. Keep your ego in check. Do you need recognition for your efforts, or are you more focused on the rewards that will come if you succeed?

A famous commander of Vietnamese forces said he got his strategy on how to defeat the United States by studying our very own War for Independence.

I want to never think of these parasites again let alone have to deal with them on my doorstep on a regular basis. As I said before, being mobile makes your doorstep a bit of a task to keep tabs on. If just 3% of the activism community would take the same basic strategy our founders took during the War for Independence I believe this modern day “war for freedom” would be long over by now.

I'm speaking metaphorically on how our founders didn't meet the mighty British toe-to-toe on most occasions. Instead they learned a few lessons from the Indians about guerrilla warfare. The rebels would attack quickly and disappear. They would fire from the shadows or heavy cover. They learned to snipe out the captains and other officers which discombobulated the enemy.

The British Army had never seen these types of tactics before (surprisingly) and were completely untrained for this kind of fight. They were being

cut down even in spite of the fact they had our patriots ridiculously out-manned.

Completing the analogy I'm referring to how many activists get bogged down in court battles for years and virtually always get taken out of commission in the process. They become useless to our cause and therefore "expendable" as well as unfortunately, forgettable. They lose their following and fade away, hoping to not have the STATE darken their doorstep again as long as they keep quiet.

If you presently do not have a firm grasp on the law and were to pit yourself against the mighty servant-sector with all of it's resources on their "court," that is equivalent to having our rag-tag independence forces meeting the British Army in the middle of a great big field, with plenty of peripheral vision.

Don't Feed the Animals

Find any way possible to stop funding the machine without getting yourself thrown in jail. Anything to do with "courts" is a major financing source for everything evil these corporations do,

so if there's any way to avoid the courts we should do it.

Your next step is to completely exit the SLAVE NOTE system (which your author is currently on). Start learning about the hundreds of exciting new crypto-currencies, all of them much more secure than any FIAT paper bill. If you're new to this information there's currently over 5 billion dollars in value stored in anonymous peer-to-peer currencies. This progress potential available to us now from this new idea in "money" is equivalent to the amount of information that became available to us once Al Gore invented the internet.

In five years' time banking as you now know it will be obsolete. The technology now exists for you and I to transfer credit across the globe instantly, with no third party whatsoever involved!

The migration back and fourth to cash is a bit cumbersome. There are only a few entities out there that want to brave the dangerous waters of exchanging any medium of exchange with the FEDERAL RESERVE NOTE, such as bankster

chains and any other organization that contracts within that system.

The FEDs resistance to those who wish to use virtual currency and exchange it freely with the dollar bill is making the dollar bill obsolete.

❖ *"As their fists clench, the grains of sand run out of the palms of their hands."*

The idea is to get away from using cash altogether, hence migration becomes a moot point if you're in this to repaint the big picture.

"Cash is King" is perhaps one of the most inaccurate sayings I've ever heard knowing what I know now. People insisting on cash and accepting no other payment have no idea they are literally digging their own graves, just a couple decades before their burial services need to be handled. How much harder must you work every day when roughly 95% of your energy is stolen through the debt-based FEDERAL SLAVE SYSTEM?

We've all heard stories from our elders of how a nickle used to buy a loaf of bread. These true tales

were based on the value of a real money nickel, containing silver which still buys the average loaf of bread today. A call to your local coin dealer regarding the current price of a silver nickle will verify this information. Americans used to be quite wealthy, they carried silver and gold around in their pockets instead of promises from a system which has long since broken its promise.

In practice this author will admit using barter systems, and doing business in gold, silver and virtual currency is not a practical solution unless there is a network of other folks around you who wish to exit the matrix too.
